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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, APRIL 30, 1979

Cold storage stocks of fresh fruits were larger than last year but fresh vegetables in storage dropped below the 1978 level. April 30 stocks of nuts in shell were above a year earlier but shelled stocks were down four percent.

Total dairy products dipped below last year because of lower butter stocks which offset larger cheese holdings. April 30 stocks of chicken were down three percent from last year but frozen turkeys were 28 percent larger.

Supplies of frozen fruits were, for most items, lower than at this time last year while frozen juice stocks were 29 percent larger. April 30 stocks of total frozen vegetables were four percent above last year.

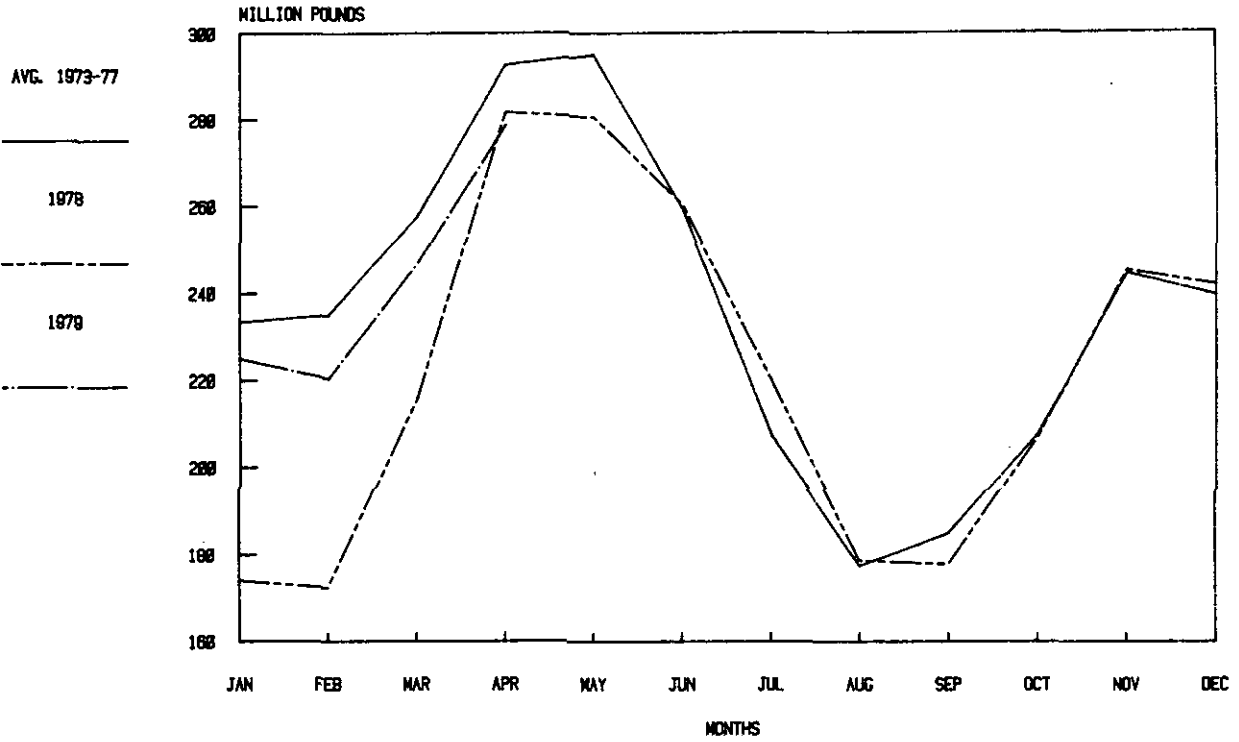
Total red meat supplies were five percent larger due principally to heavier stocks of frozen beef and canned meats. Frozen pork stocks, including pork bellies, were down slightly from year ago levels but up seasonally from last month.
