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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1979

May 31 stocks in refrigerated warehouses topped year earlier holdings for many of the major food items requiring refrigeration, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Fresh fruits were 92 percent larger than in 1978 but fresh vegetables were 18 percent smaller.

May 31 supplies of nuts, in shell and shelled, totalled 556 million pounds, 11 percent above 1978. Total cheese, at 493 million pounds, compared with 463 million pounds in May 31, 1978. Butter supplies, at 237 million pounds, did not reach the 265 million pounds stored on May 31, 1978.

Shell egg and frozen egg stocks showed a good seasonal gain but inventories fell below year earlier levels. This also was true for frozen chicken but May 31 stocks of frozen turkeys, at 154 million pounds, were 48 percent larger than at this time last year.

Total red meats on May 31 amounted to 797 million pounds, 5 percent larger than last year. Total beef stocks were drawn down during May but end-of-month inventories exceeded year earlier stocks by 5 percent. Strong May buildup for the major pork cuts brought May 31 stocks to 295 million pounds, 5 percent more than last year.

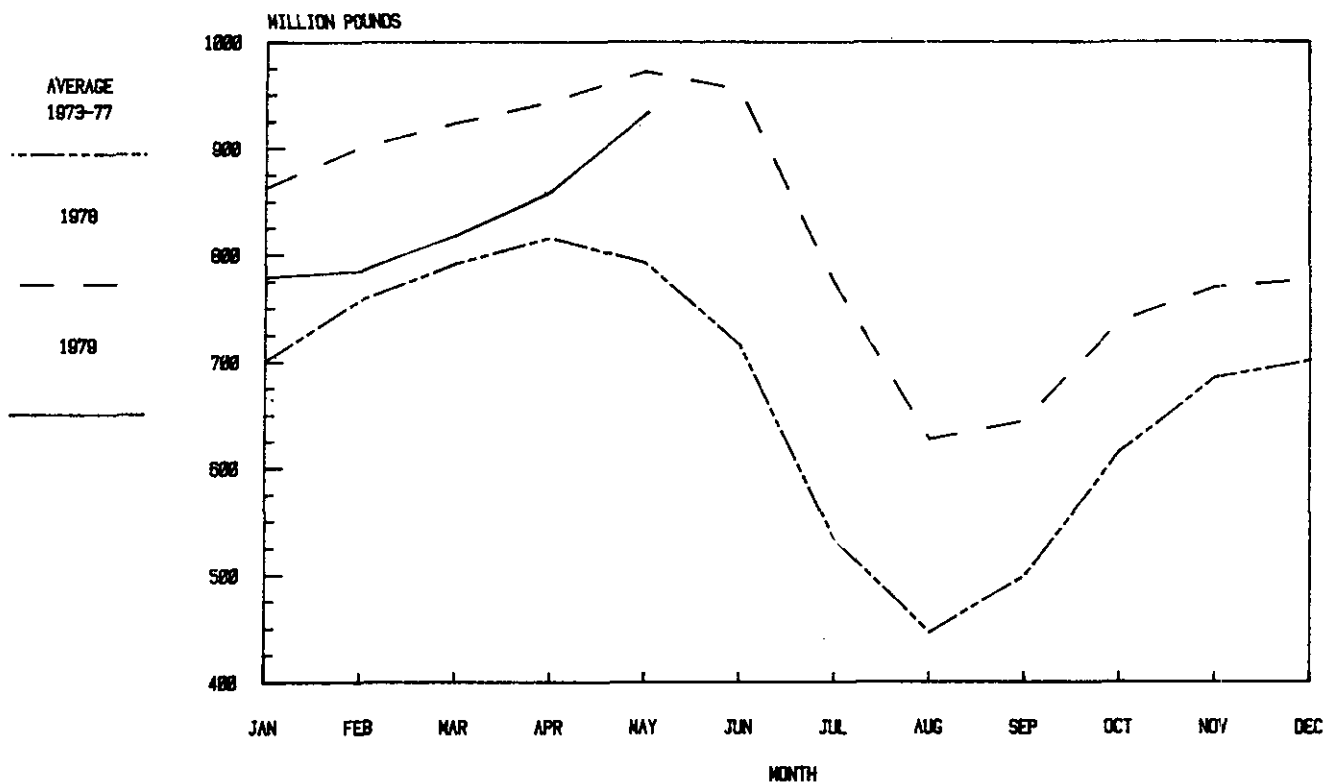
Rounding out the supply picture, warehouse stocks of frozen juices and frozen vegetables exceeded last year's totals but frozen fruit stocks did not. The 927 million pounds of frozen potatoes were also below year earlier levels.

Warehouse occupancy, at 60 percent for coolers and 69 percent for freezers was higher than a year earlier.
