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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JUNE 30, 1979

Mid-year supplies of apples, cheese, frozen juice, meats, poultry and vegetables (including potatoes) were in larger supply than at this time last year, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of butter, frozen eggs and frozen fruits slipped below 1978 levels.

Red meat supplies totaled 739 million pounds, up 3 percent from last year. Frozen beef stored on June 30 was 5 percent larger than a year earlier but frozen pork stocks were about the same as last year. Pork bellies, at 78.9 million pounds, were the largest for June 30 since 1972. With 33 percent more turkeys in storage than at this time last year, total poultry supplies were about 29 percent above 1978. Supplies of turkeys were the largest for the date since 1974.

Frozen juices were almost one-third above June 30, 1978 stocks and frozen vegetables about 12 percent higher primarily because of strong seasonal gains for asparagus, green peas, and broccoli. Frozen potatoes, at 794 million pounds, were slightly above last year's mark.

Supplies of frozen fruits increased to 402 million pounds but fell 8 percent short of last year's total. Dairy stocks were up for frozen cream and cheese but butter, despite a 12 million pound increase during June, was down 11 percent from a year earlier.

The boost in freezer stocks during June brought freezer occupancy up to 70 percent, about 3 points more than last year. Cooler occupancy fell off from 60 percent last month to 58 percent on June 30.

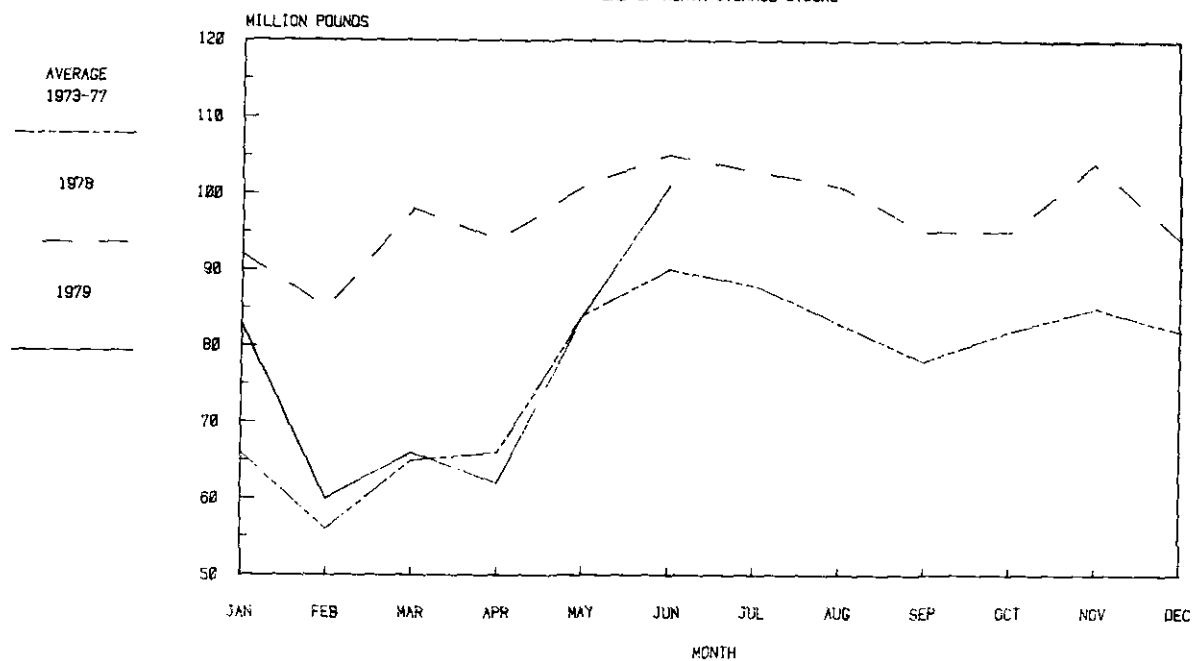
