COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JULY 31, 1979

July 31, supplies of frozen pork, beef, chickens, turkeys, potatoes, juices, vegetables, and cheese were larger than at this time last year, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Slipping below year earlier levels were supplies of nut-meats, butter, frozen eggs, fruits, veal and lamb.

Pork stocks declined seasonally and at 226 million pounds topped year earlier stocks by three percent. Beef in storage was eight percent higher than last year with a 365 million pound July 31 inventory. The July build-up in frozen chickens, heavier than a year earlier, brought end-of-month stocks to 134 million pounds, 24 percent larger than last year. Frozen turkeys at 271 million pounds, was the largest for the date since 1974 and the second largest on record for this time of year.

Holdings of frozen vegetables totaled 1.38 billion pounds, up 20 percent from a month earlier and 16 percent from a year earlier. Stocks of frozen juices declined seasonally but were still 27 percent larger than last year. Frozen fruit inventories slipped below last year's total even with a 17 percent gain over the previous month.

Stocks of frozen potatoes were lowered during July and at month's end stood at 874 million pounds - 13 percent more than last year.

Butter holdings, at 252 million pounds, were down 15 percent from last year but stocks of American cheese increased 6 percent during the month to a total of 459 million pounds. This was 9 percent above last year.

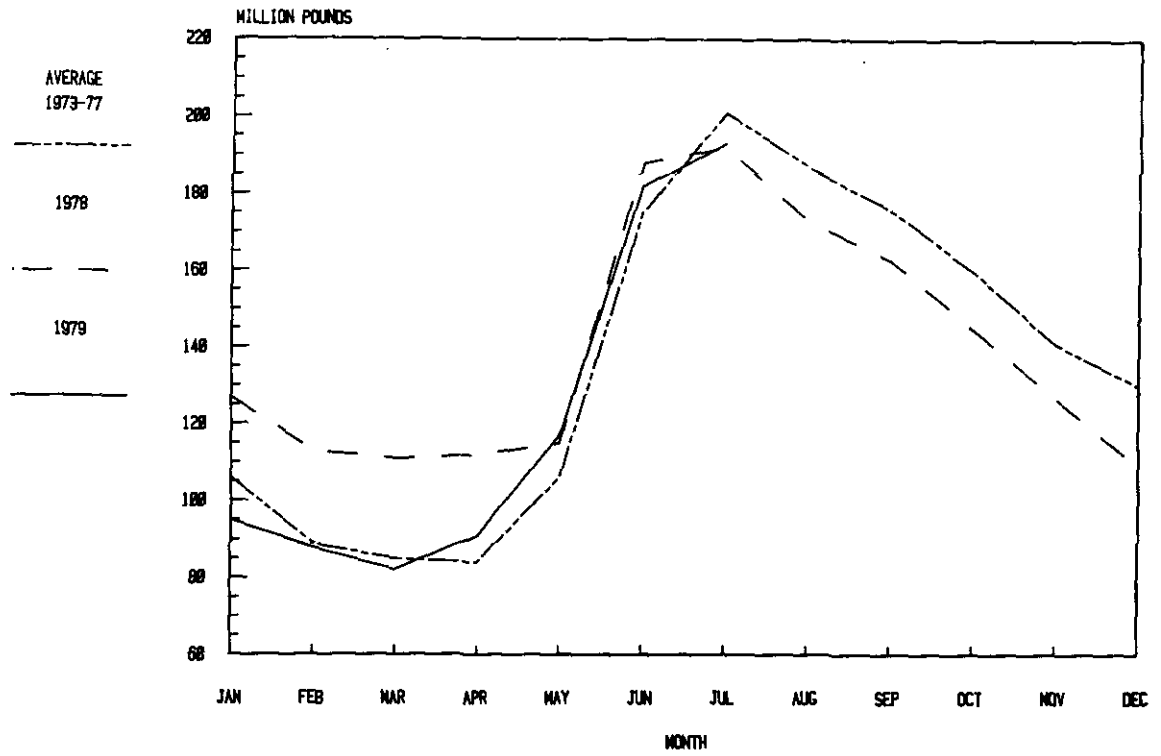
Freezer occupancy increased seasonally to 72 percent, 2 points above last month and 4 points above last year. Cooler occupancy at 58 percent was unchanged from the previous month and year earlier.
