COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, AUGUST 31, 1979

For the fall and holiday seasons ahead, refrigerated stocks of turkeys, chickens, beef, pork, and frozen vegetables are in larger supply than a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Stocks of turkeys were at 379 million pounds, up 26 percent from 1978. Frozen chicken in storage, at 139 million pounds, was 27 percent more than a year ago. Total beef stocks were 323 million pounds on August 31, about 2 percent more than last year. The 181 million pounds of pork topped last year's total by one percent. Frozen vegetable supplies were up 10 percent from last year with 1.65 billion pounds in storage, a gain of 19 percent over the previous month. Frozen potatoes decreased seasonally, but at 695 million pounds they were 11 percent larger than a year ago.

Fresh apples will begin to move into storage next month. Bartlett pears in storage on August 31 totaled 88.1 million pounds compared with 54 million last year.

Stocks of peanuts were down slightly from last year but pecan stocks were double those of a year ago. Butter holdings fell off to 237 million pounds, a drop of 17 percent from last year but cheese supplies advanced to 547 million pounds, about 12 percent more than at this time last year.

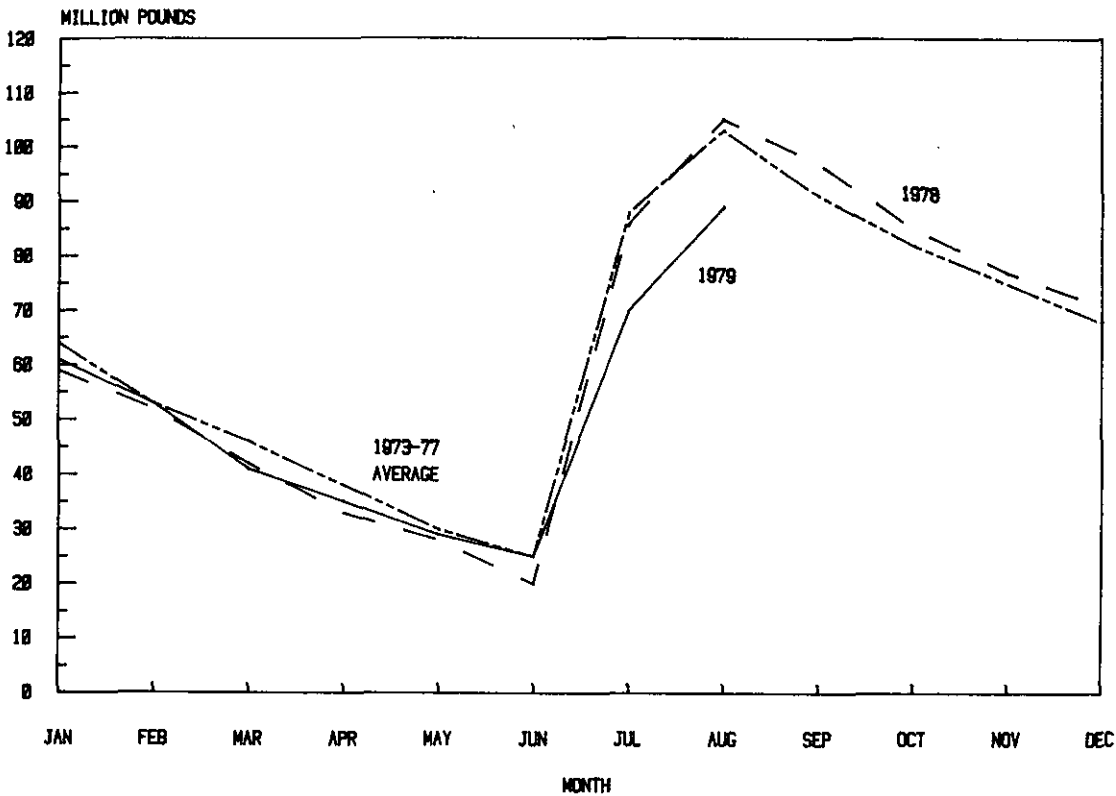
Freezer occupancy was 72 percent on August 31 the same as the previous month but 3 points higher than last year. Cooler occupancy, at 59 percent, was up 1 point from last month and 2 points from last year.
