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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1979

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30 were above year earlier levels for juice, vegetables and poultry according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items in larger supply were fresh fruits, vegetables, nuts and cheese. Stocks of butter, frozen eggs, frozen fruits and red meats continued below 1978, while potatoes slipped to the minus side for the first time since last May.

Red meat stocks were down 8 percent from last year and September was the second consecutive month that red meat supplies were below the previous year. Pork bellie stocks continued to decline seasonally, but were almost double the 1978 level and the largest September holdings since 1974.

Total frozen poultry supplies were up 19 percent from the previous year. Whole turkeys accounted for over one-half the total poultry and were the largest holdings for this date since 1976.

Total frozen vegetable stocks increased 16 percent from last month and were 7 percent above last year's supply. Frozen corn, lima beans, green beans and cauliflower were the principal vegetables entering freezers during September.

Supplies of frozen fruits continued to make seasonal gains during the month, but fell 5 percent short of the previous year's total. Total frozen juice concentrate declined seasonally but was 14 percent above 1978.

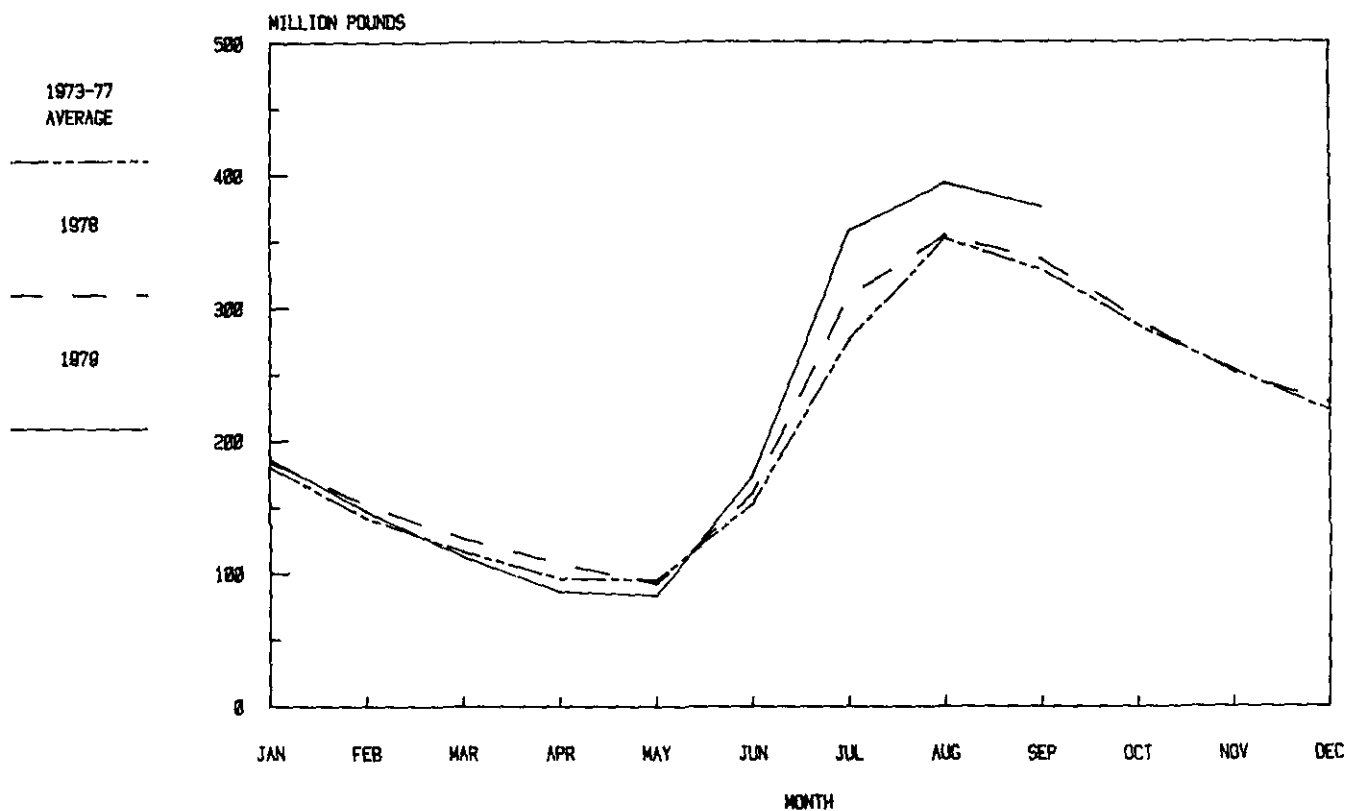
Freezer occupancy increased to 74 percent, 1 point above last month and 2 points above the previous year. Cooler occupancy at 58 percent was down 1 point from last month.
