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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, OCTOBER 31, 1979

Freezer stocks in refrigerated warehouses on October 31 were up seasonally for vegetables, potatoes, red meats, poultry and fruits, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items also up seasonally, were fresh fruits, nuts, and vegetables. Refrigerated items that declined from the previous month were orange concentrate, total natural cheese, butter, and shell eggs.

Total frozen poultry stocks were in good supply for the holiday season, increasing 3 percent during September and were 13 percent more than in October 1978.

Red meat stocks rose 9 percent in September but fell 6 percent short of the previous year's total. Stocks of pork bellies increased 61 percent during the month, but were down 11 percent from last year.

Supplies of frozen vegetables continued to make seasonal gains with an increase of 5 percent from last month and 6 percent from last year. Total frozen potatoes jumped 15 percent during the month and were 1 percent more than in 1978.

Total frozen fruit stocks increased 7 percent from last month but were 1 percent short of the previous year's total. Total frozen juice concentrates continued to drop seasonally but were 7 percent ahead of 1978.

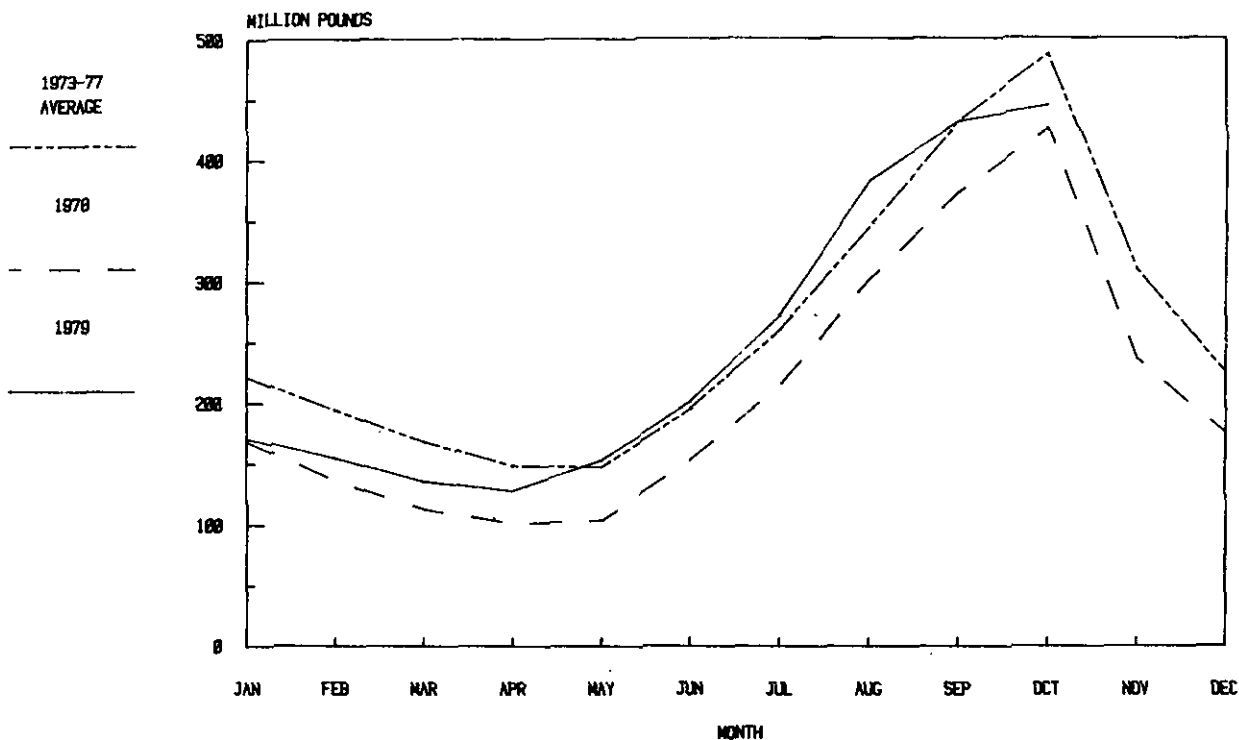
Freezer occupancy increased to 77 percent, 3 points above last month and 2 points more than the previous year. Cooler occupancy at 59 percent was 1 point above last month.
