COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, NOVEMBER 30, 1979

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on November 30 were above year earlier levels for poultry, fruits, juice concentrates, vegetables and pork according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items in larger supply were fresh fruits, dried fruits, nuts and cheese. Stocks of butter, frozen eggs and frozen beef continued below 1978.

Red meat stocks were down 8 percent from last year and November was the fourth consecutive month that red meat supplies were less than the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies more than doubled during the month and at 3 percent more than the previous year were the largest November holdings since 1971.

Total frozen poultry supplies were 23 percent more than last year and have remained above year earlier levels since February. Total turkey stocks declined 39 percent and chicken stocks 8 percent during November.

Frozen potato stocks increased 4 percent from last month and were 3 percent above 1978 holdings. Total frozen vegetables were 1 percent below the previous month but 6 percent above the previous year.

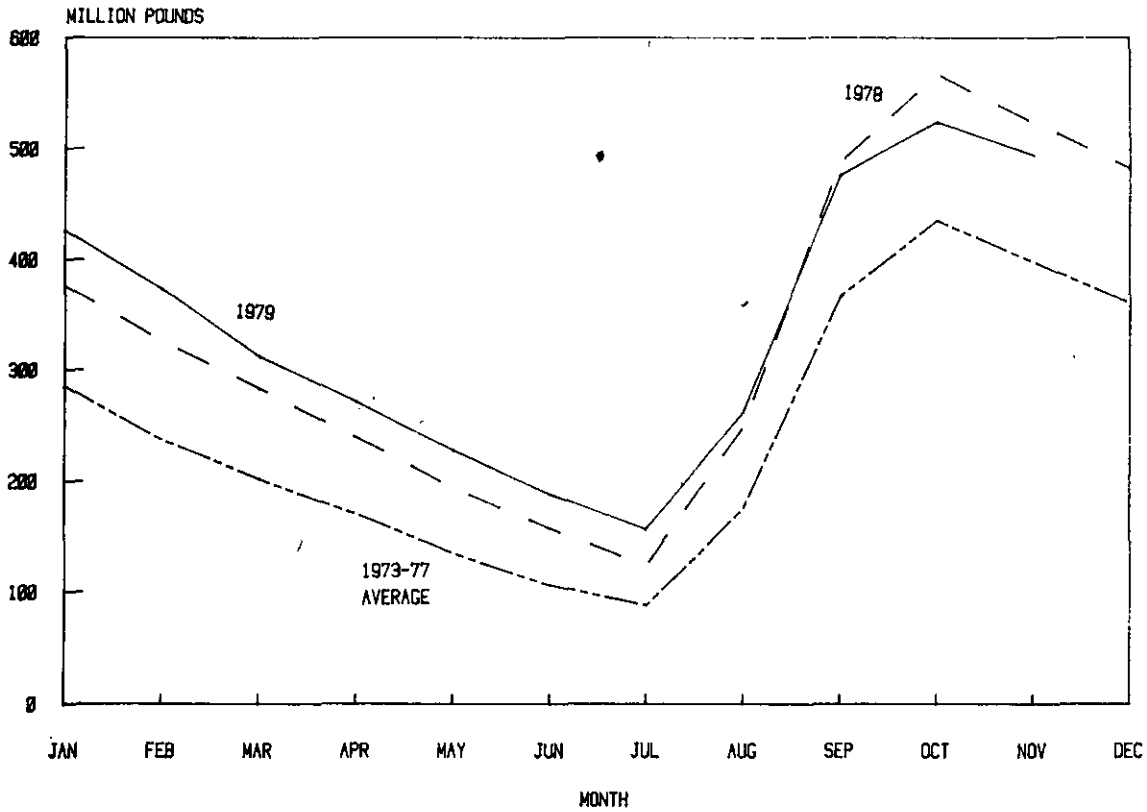
Public cooler occupancy was 60 percent, up 1 point from October 31. Freezer occupancy at 76 percent was down 1 point from last month, but 2 points above last year.
