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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, DECEMBER 31, 1979

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on December 31 were above year earlier levels for poultry, fruits, juice concentrates, vegetables, potatoes and pork, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Frozen stocks up seasonally were orange juice concentrates, beef and pork.

The new processing season for orange juice concentrates is underway with December 31 holdings up 20 percent from last month and 10 percent from 1978.

Total red meats increased 8 percent from last month but fell 2 percent short of the previous year's holdings. Pork bellie stocks were up sharply from last month and at 70.5 million pounds were the largest December holdings since 1971.

Total frozen poultry supplies dropped 11 percent from last month but were 38 percent above the previous year. Total turkey stocks declined 14 percent during December and chicken 5 percent.

Total frozen vegetable stocks were 8 percent below the previous month but 4 percent above the previous year. Frozen apple stocks increased 21 percent during December, however total frozen fruits decreased 5 percent seasonally.

**OCCUPANCY:** Public cooler occupancy was at 58 percent of capacity, down 1 point from November. Freezer occupancy at 74 percent was 2 points below November but 2 points above December 1978.

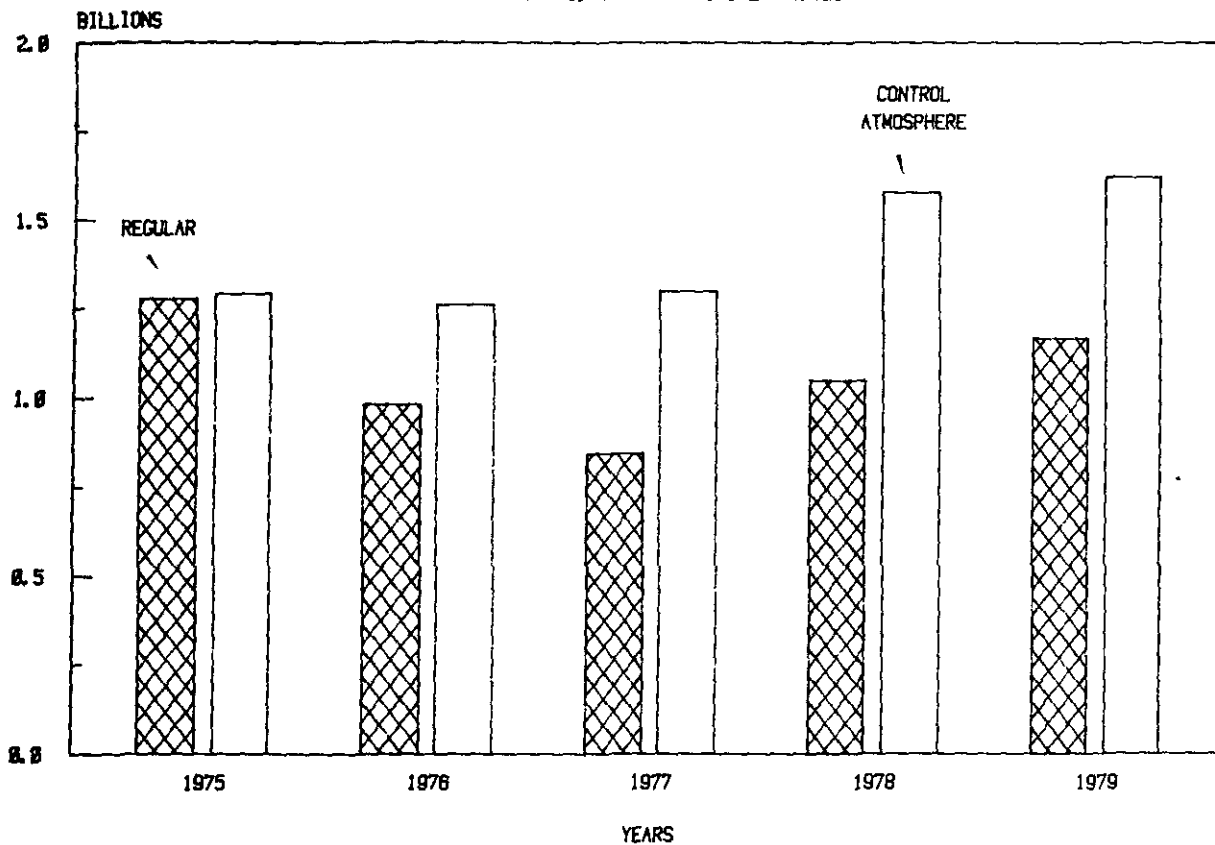
