## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JANUARY 31, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31 were above year earlier levels for poultry, potatoes, vegetables, fruits and pork according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items above the previous year included shell eggs, fresh vegetables, natural cheese, fruits and nuts.

Total juice concentrate holdings continued to make strong seasonal gains with January 31 stocks up 38 percent from December and 2 percent above the previous year.

Total red meats increased 4 percent from last month and 1 percent above last year. Frozen pork stocks increased 1 percent during the month and were 27 percent above 1979. Pork bellie stocks were 77 percent above 1979 and the largest January holdings since 1972. Beef holdings were up 6 percent from last month but were 13 percent below the previous year.

Total frozen poultry stocks rose 1 percent in January and were 39 percent above 1979. Total turkeys increased 4 percent from last month and 46 percent above last year.

Total frozen vegetables declined 13 percent during the month but were 4 percent above last year. Total frozen fruits were down 9 percent from last month but were 3 percent above last year.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 59 percent of capacity, unchanged from December. Freezer occupancy at 72 percent was 2 points below December, but 3 points above January 1979.
