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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, FEBRUARY 29, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on February 29 were above year earlier levels for poultry, pork, potatoes, vegetables, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items above the previous year included shell eggs, natural cheese, fresh vegetables, and fruits.

Total juice concentrate holdings continued to increase seasonally with February 29 stocks up 22 percent from January and 2 percent above the previous year.

Total red meats declined 2 percent from last month, but remained above the previous year by 2 percent. Frozen pork stocks dropped 4 percent during the month but were 24 percent above the previous year. Pork bellie stocks were 83 percent above 1979 and the largest February holdings since 1972. Beef holdings were down 2 percent from last month and 10 percent from the previous year.

Total frozen poultry stocks were down 7 percent from January but were 39 percent above last year. Total turkeys dropped 11 percent during the month but were 43 percent above 1979.

Total frozen vegetables declined 11 percent during the month but were 9 percent above last year. Total frozen fruits were down 12 percent from January and 3 percent from last year.

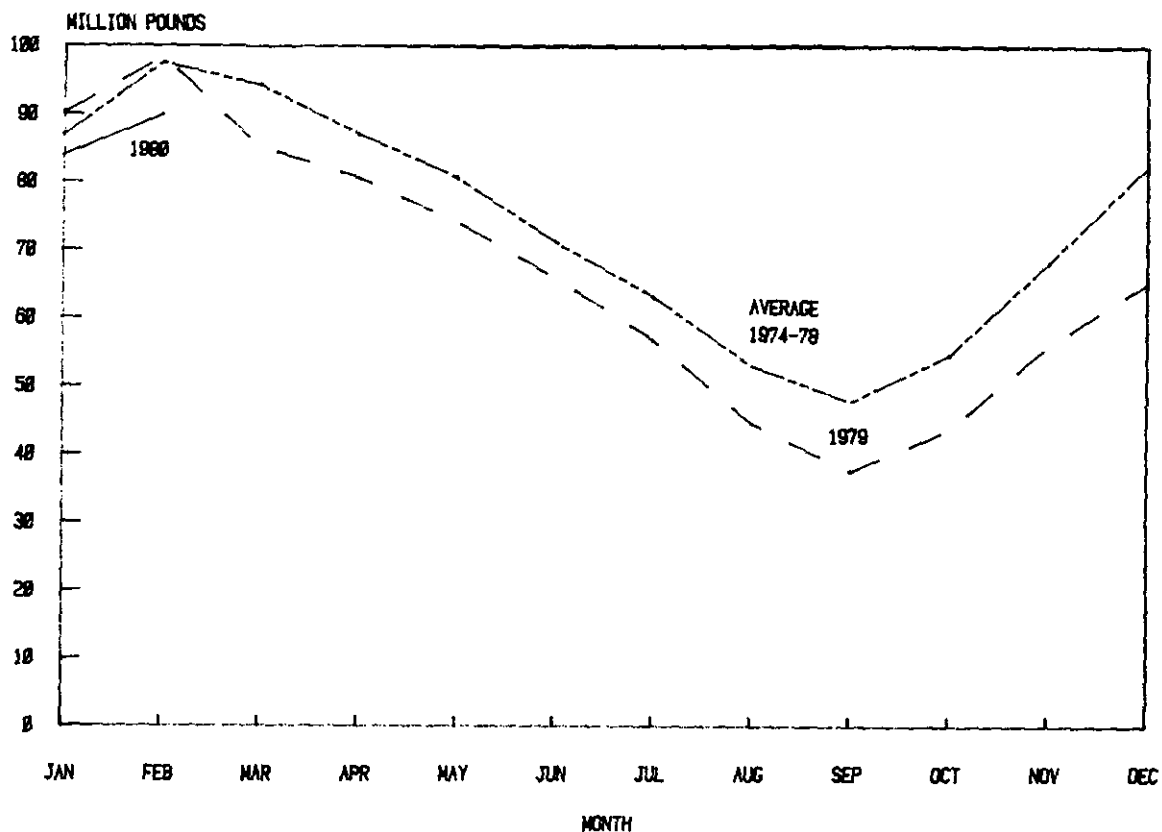
OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 59 percent of capacity, unchanged from January. Freezer occupancy, at 70 percent, was 2 points below January, but 2 points above February 1979.
