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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MARCH 31, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on March 31 were above year earlier levels for poultry, pork, eggs, potatoes, vegetables, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, natural cheese, and fresh fruits.

Total red meats declined 2 percent from last month and 8 percent from the previous year. Frozen beef dropped 6 percent during the month and was 21 percent below the previous year. Total frozen pork stocks increased 7 percent from February and were 18 percent above 1979. Pork bellie stocks were up 26 percent from last month and 48 percent from last year. This was the largest March holdings for pork bellies since 1972.

Total frozen poultry stocks were down 1 percent from February but were 50 percent more than last year. Total turkey stocks dropped 7 percent during the month but were 53 percent above 1979. Stocks of frozen chickens increased 8 percent from last month and were 45 percent above the previous year.

Total juice concentrate holdings were 10 percent above the previous month and the previous year. Total frozen vegetables declined 10 percent from February but were 10 percent above 1979. Total frozen fruits were down 12 percent during the month and 2 percent below last year.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 59 percent of capacity, unchanged from February. Public freezer occupancy, at 69 percent, was 1 point below February, but 3 points above March 1979.

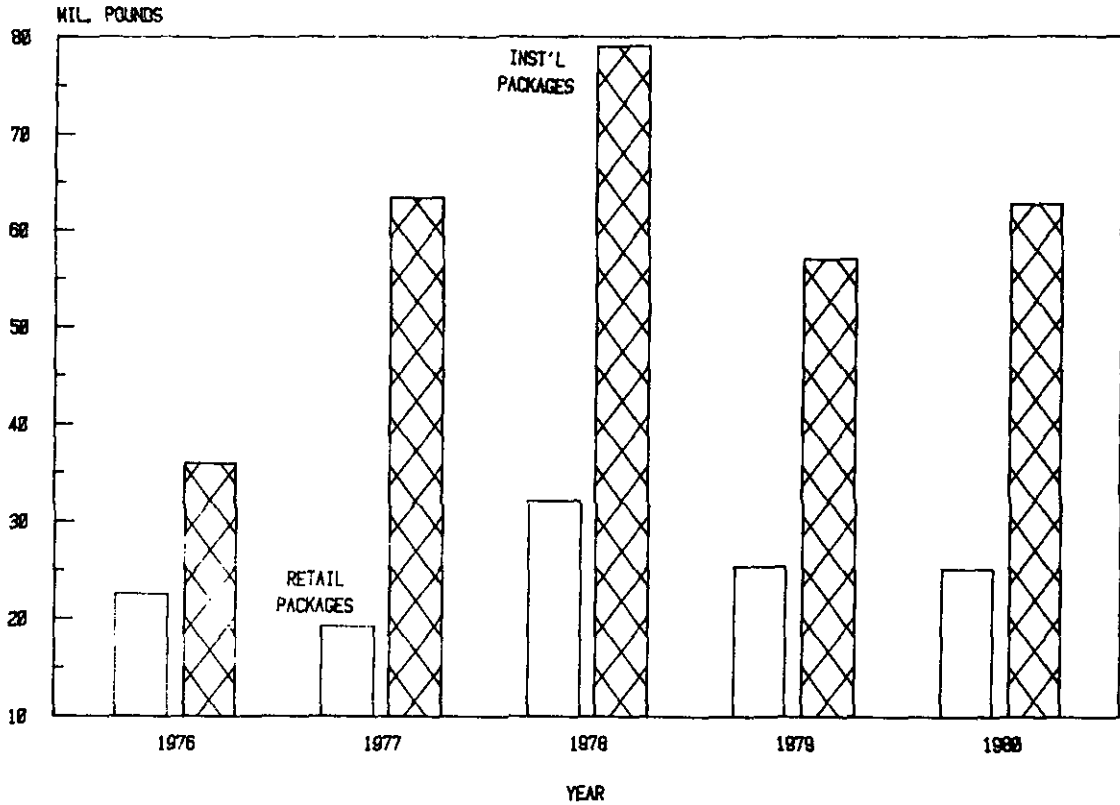
