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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, APRIL 30, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on April 30 were greater than year earlier levels for poultry, pork, juice concentrates, vegetables, eggs, butter, and potatoes, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs, dried and evaporated fruits, nuts, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in storage increased 2 percent from March but were 9 percent less than in April 1979. Frozen beef stocks dropped 12 percent during the month and were 27 percent below the previous year. Total frozen pork stocks increased 18 percent from March and were 23 percent above 1979. Pork bellie stocks were up 14 percent from last month and 40 percent from last year. This was the largest April holdings for pork bellies since 1972.

Total stocks of frozen poultry were up 1 percent from March and were 55 percent more than last year. Total chicken stocks increased 7 percent during the month and were 50 percent more than 1979. Stocks of frozen turkeys dropped 3 percent from last month but were 59 percent above the previous year.

Total juice concentrate holdings were 10 percent more than the previous month and 16 percent above the previous year. Total frozen vegetables declined 8 percent from March but were 9 percent above 1979. Total frozen fruits were down 10 percent during the month and 3 percent below last year.

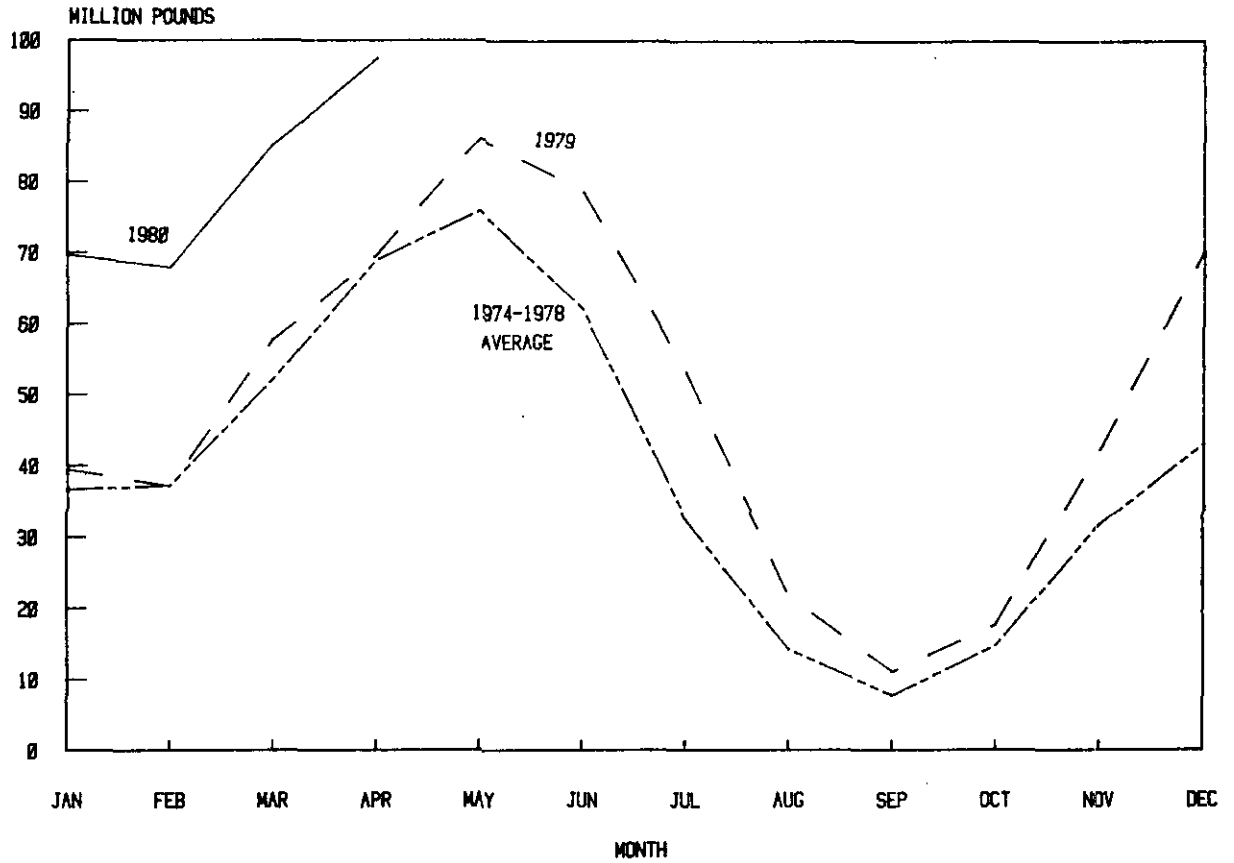
Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 60 percent of capacity, 1 point above March. Public freezer occupancy, at 68 percent, was 1 point below March, but 2 points above April 1979.
