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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on May 31 were greater than year earlier levels for cream, poultry, eggs, juice concentrates, butter, vegetables, and potatoes, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs, dried and evaporated fruits, natural cheese, fresh vegetables and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers declined 1 percent from April 30 and were 11 percent less than those on May 31, 1979. Frozen beef stocks dropped 6 percent during the month and were down one-third from the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 9 percent from last month and 24 percent from last year.

Total frozen poultry stocks were up 9 percent from April and 52 percent from last year. Total turkey stocks increased 15 percent during the month and were 58 percent more than in 1979. Total chickens in freezers were up slightly from last month and were 44 percent more than the previous year.

Total juice concentrate holdings were 14 percent more than the previous month and 22 percent above the previous year. Total frozen vegetables declined 8 percent from April but were 8 percent above 1979. Total frozen fruits were down 6 percent from last month and last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 62 percent of capacity, 2 points above April. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was 1 point less than last month and last year.

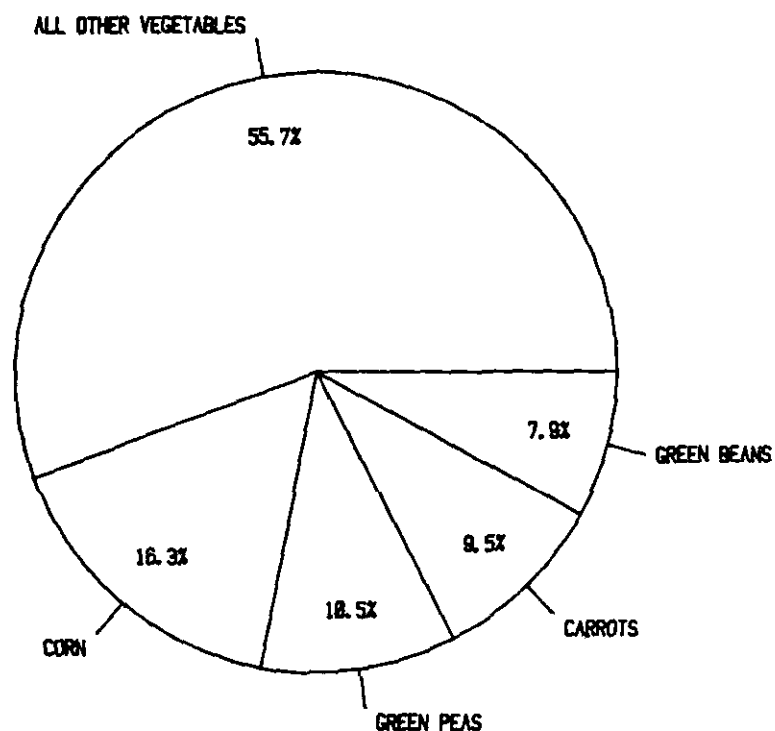
