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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JUNE 30, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on June 30 were greater than year earlier levels for cream, poultry, eggs, juice concentrates, pork, butter, fruit, and vegetables, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included dried and evaporated fruits, natural cheese, and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers declined 10 percent from May 31 and were 16 percent less than those on June 30, 1979. Frozen pork stocks dropped 13 percent during the month but were 16 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 9 percent from last month but were 23 percent above 1979.

Total frozen poultry stocks increased 14 percent from May and were 40 percent above last year. Total turkey stocks increased 22 percent during the month and were 43 percent more than in 1979. Total chickens in freezers were up 2 percent from last month and 33 percent from last year.

Total juice concentrate holdings were 4 percent more than the previous month and 21 percent above the previous year. Total frozen fruits were up 21 percent from May and 1 percent above 1979. Total frozen vegetables increased 1 percent during the month and were up slightly from last year.

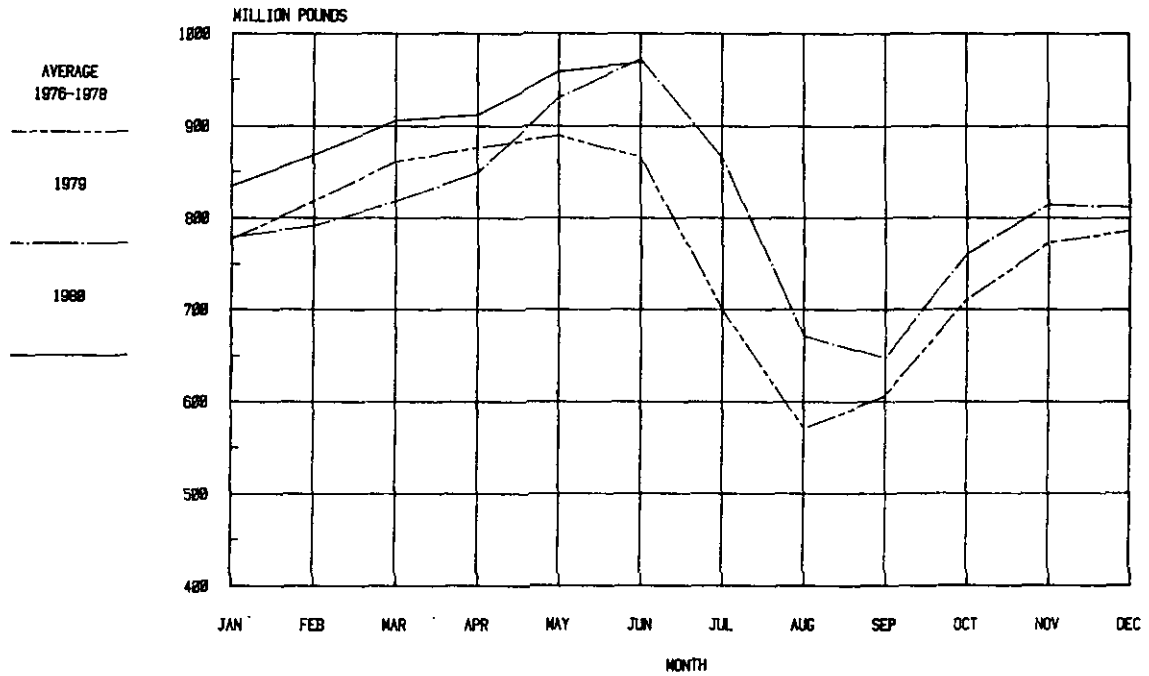
Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 63 percent of capacity, 1 point above May. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was 1 point above last month but 2 points below last year.
