COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JULY 31, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on July 31 were greater than year earlier levels for cream, poultry, juice concentrates, pork, fruits, butter, and eggs, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated milk, vegetables, fruits, dried fruits, shell eggs, natural cheese, and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers declined 10 percent from June 30 and were 16 percent less than those on July 31, 1979. Frozen pork stocks dropped 16 percent during the month but were 17 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 29 percent from last month but were 29 percent above 1979.

Total frozen poultry stocks increased 7 percent from June and were 21 percent above last year. Total turkey stocks increased 13 percent during the month and were 20 percent more than 1979. Total chickens in freezers were down 3 percent from last month but were 22 percent above last year.

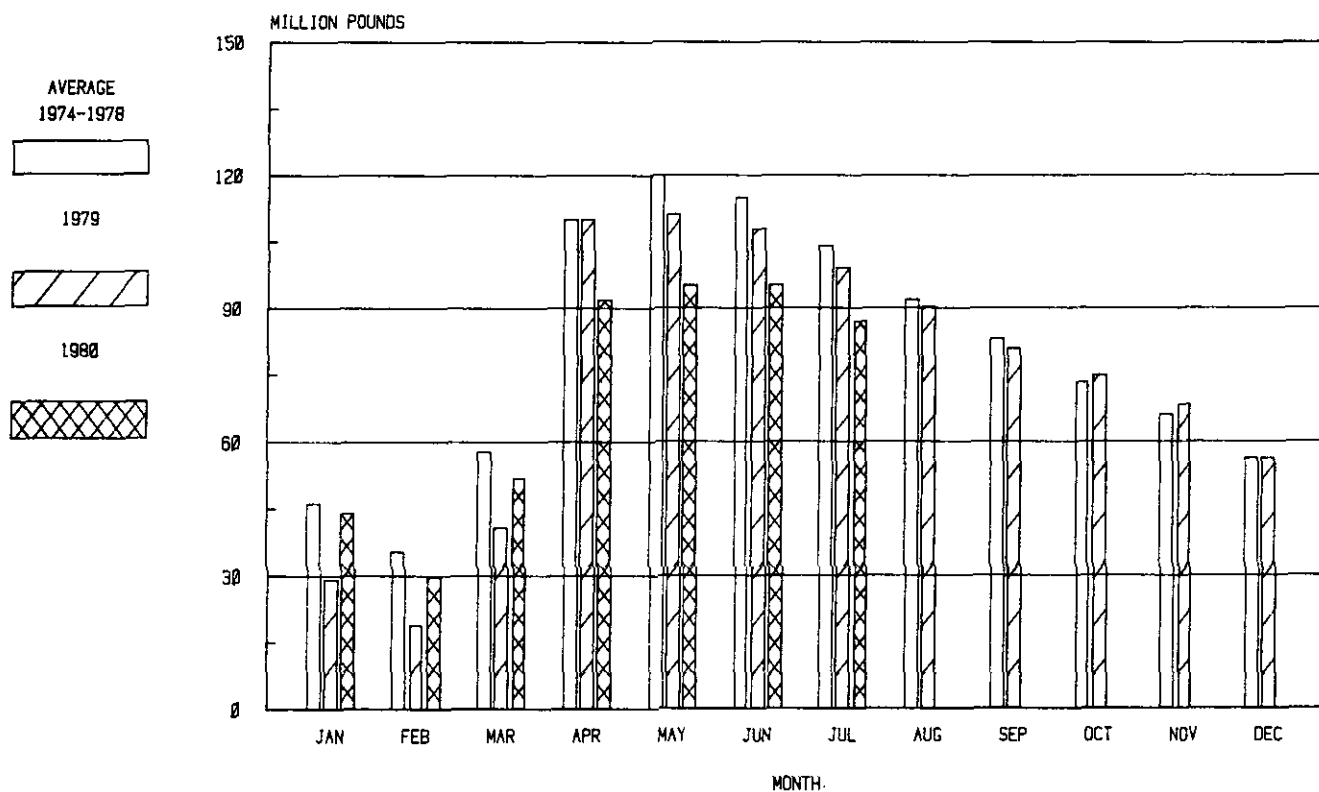
Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 64 percent of capacity, 1 point above June. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was 1 point above last month but 4 points below last year.
