## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, AUGUST 31, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on August 31 were greater than year earlier levels for cream, juice concentrates, butter, pork, eggs, fruits, and poultry, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included vegetables, evaporated milk, dried fruits, natural cheese, and shell eggs.

Total red meats in freezers declined 10 percent from July 31 and were 11 percent less than those on August 31, 1979. Frozen pork stocks dropped 17 percent during the month but were 22 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 49 percent from last month but were 59 percent above 1979.

Total frozen poultry stocks increased 10 percent from July and were 3 percent above last year. Total chickens stocks declined 3 percent during the month but were 14 percent above last year. Total turkeys in freezers were up 17 percent from last month but were down slightly from last year.

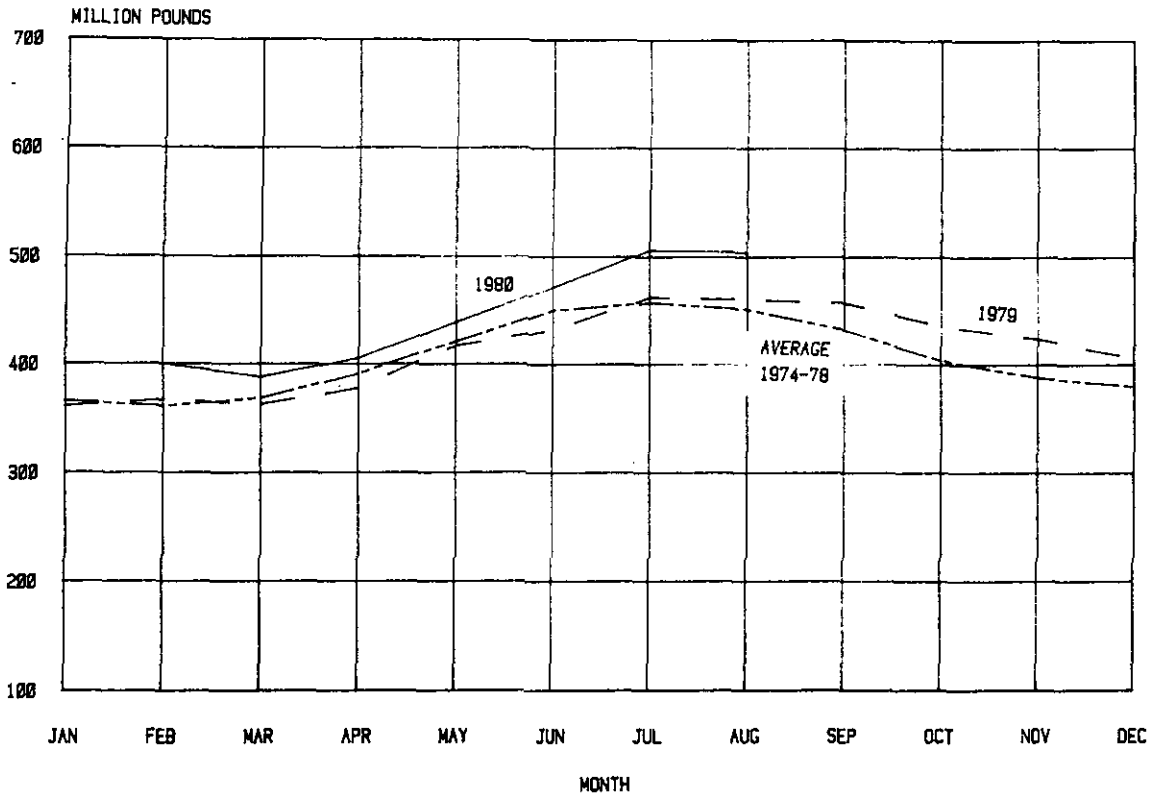
Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 63 percent of capacity, 1 point below July. Public freezer occupancy at 69 percent was 1 point above last month but 4 points below last year.
