

# COLD STORAGE

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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30 were greater than year earlier levels for cream, juice concentrates, butter, eggs, pork, and fruits, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated milk, dried fruits, shell eggs, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 2 percent from August 31 and were 8 percent less than those on September 30, 1979. Frozen pork stocks dropped 1 percent during the month but were 21 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 37 percent from last month but were 97 percent above 1979.

Total frozen poultry stocks increased 3 percent from August but were 4 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 5 percent during the month and were down slightly from last year. The number of turkeys in freezers was up 6 percent from last month but down 6 percent from last year.

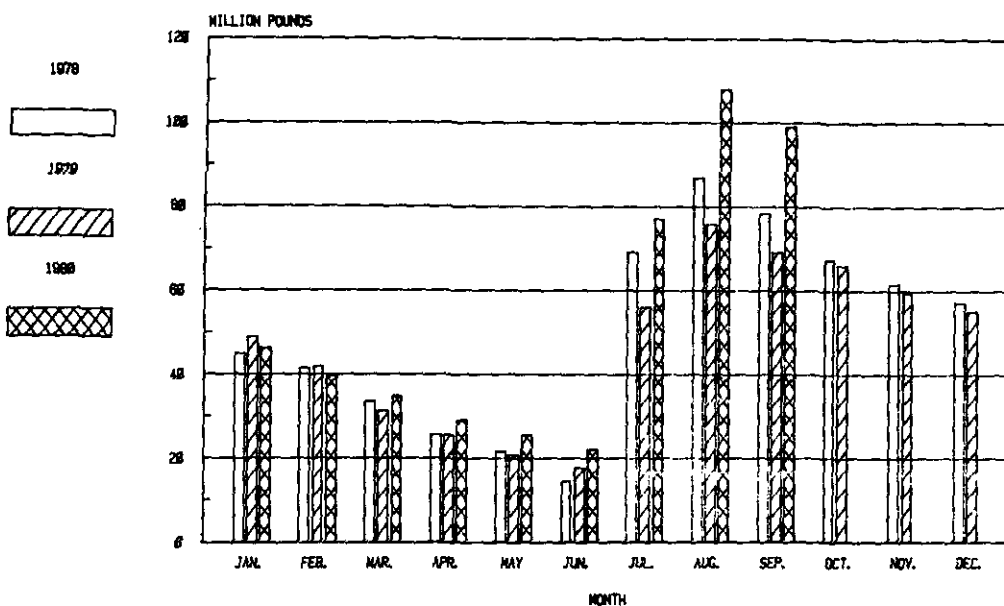
Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 60 percent of capacity, 3 points below August. Public freezer occupancy at 71 percent was 2 points above last month but 3 points below last year.
