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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, NOVEMBER 30, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on November 30 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, juice concentrates, pork, cream, eggs, fruits, and potatoes, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated milk, dried fruits, fresh fruits and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers increased 17 percent from October 31 and were 4 percent greater than those on November 30, 1979. Frozen pork stocks rose 20 percent during the month and were 25 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies, up 71 percent from last month and last year, were the largest November holdings on record.

Total frozen potato stocks were 9 percent above October and slightly above the previous year. Total frozen vegetables decreased 3 percent during the month and were 11 percent below the previous year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 60 percent of capacity, 1 point below October. Public freezer occupancy at 74 percent was 1 point below last month and 2 points below last year.

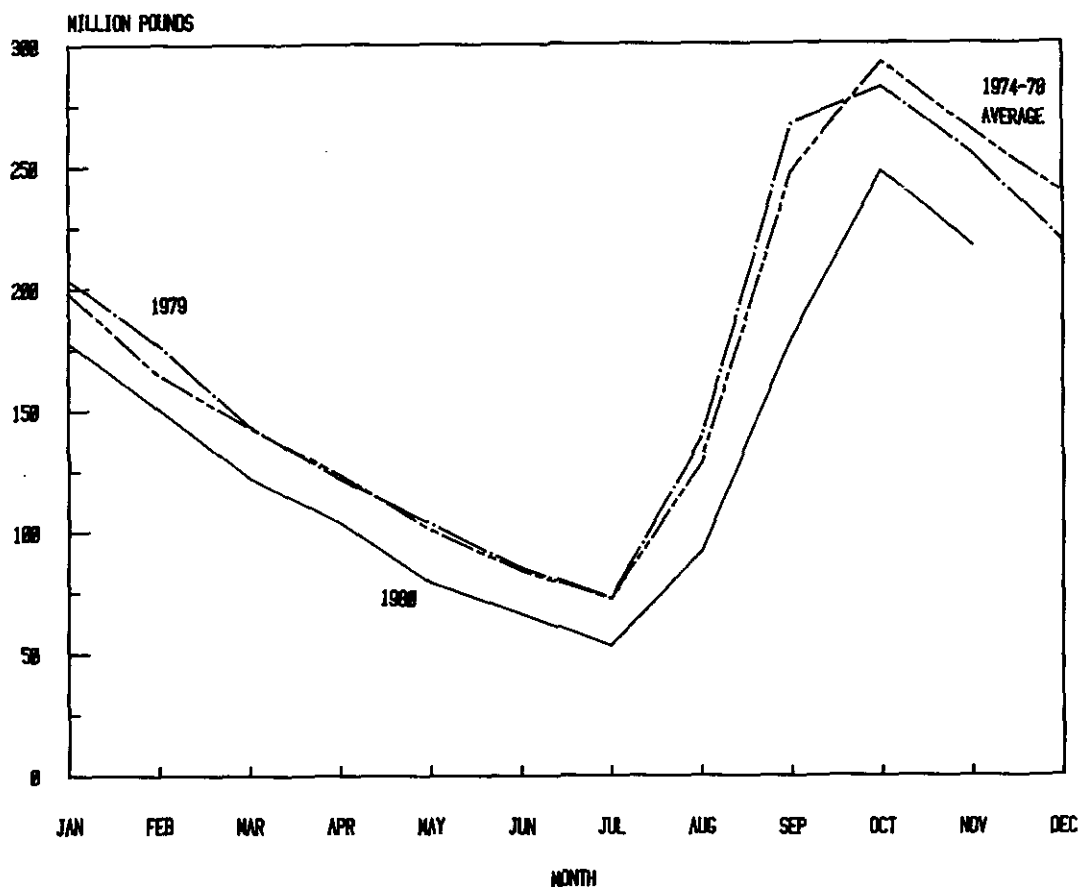
