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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, DECEMBER 31, 1980

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on December 31 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, juice concentrates, pork, eggs, fruits, and cream, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated milk, dried fruits, fresh fruits, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers increased 9 percent from November 30 and were 5 percent more than those on December 31, 1979. Frozen pork stocks rose 9 percent during the month and were 25 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies, up 35 percent from last month and 39 percent from last year, were the largest December holdings on record.

The new processing season for orange juice concentrates is underway with December 31 holdings up 6 percent from November 30 and 29 percent above 1979. Total frozen fruits decreased 8 percent during the month but were 3 percent above the previous year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 59 percent of capacity, 1 point below November. Public freezer occupancy at 71 percent was 2 points below last month and 3 points below last year.

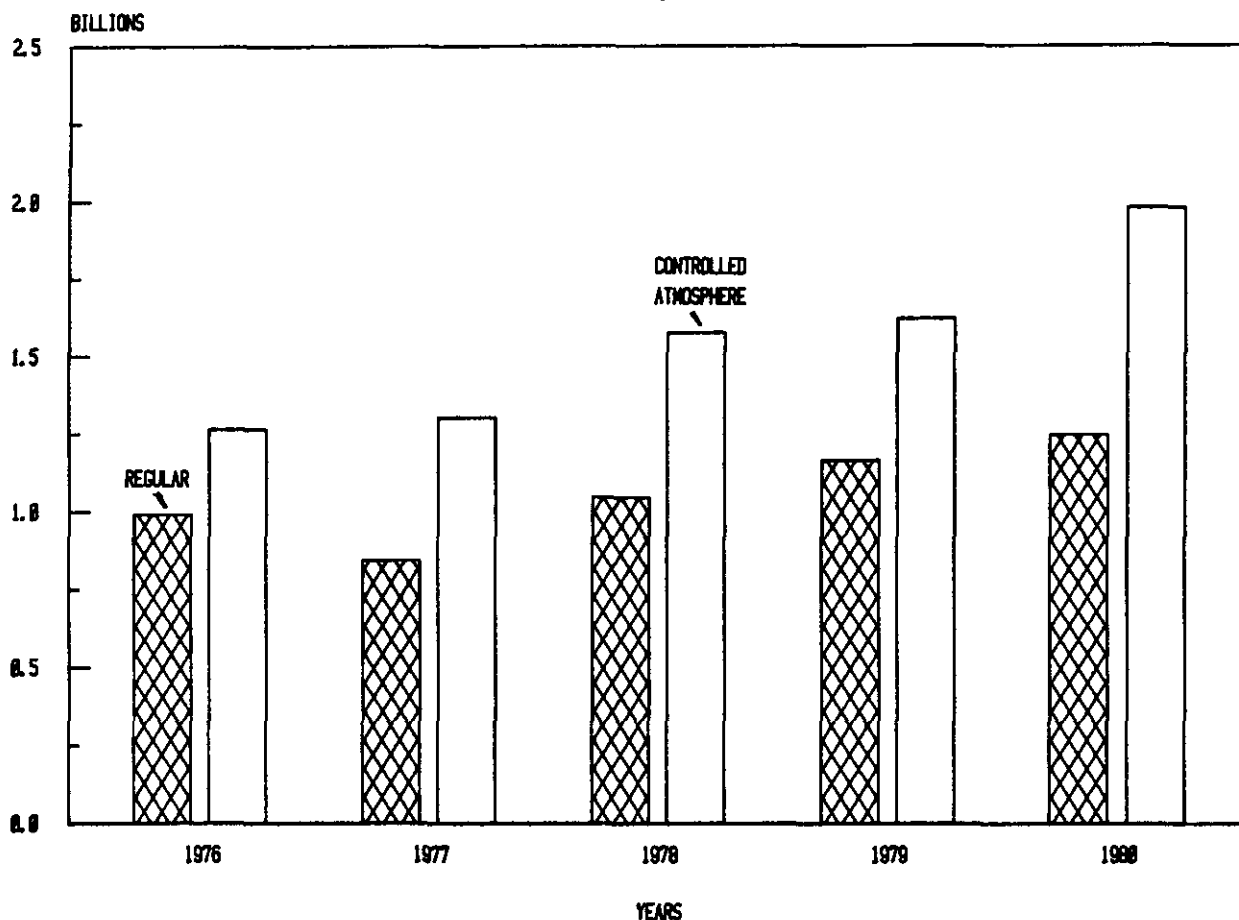
