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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, FEBRUARY 28, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on February 28 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, pork, fruits, juice concentrates, chickens, and eggs, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated milk, fresh fruits, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 1 percent from January 31 but were 10 percent more than the February 29, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 1 percent during the month and were 32 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 4 percent from last month and 39 percent above 1980.

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 1 percent from last month and were 3 percent below last year. Total stocks of chicken declined 3 percent during the month but were 3 percent above 1980. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up slightly from last month but were down 7 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 58 percent of capacity, 2 points below January. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was 1 point below last month and 2 points below last year.

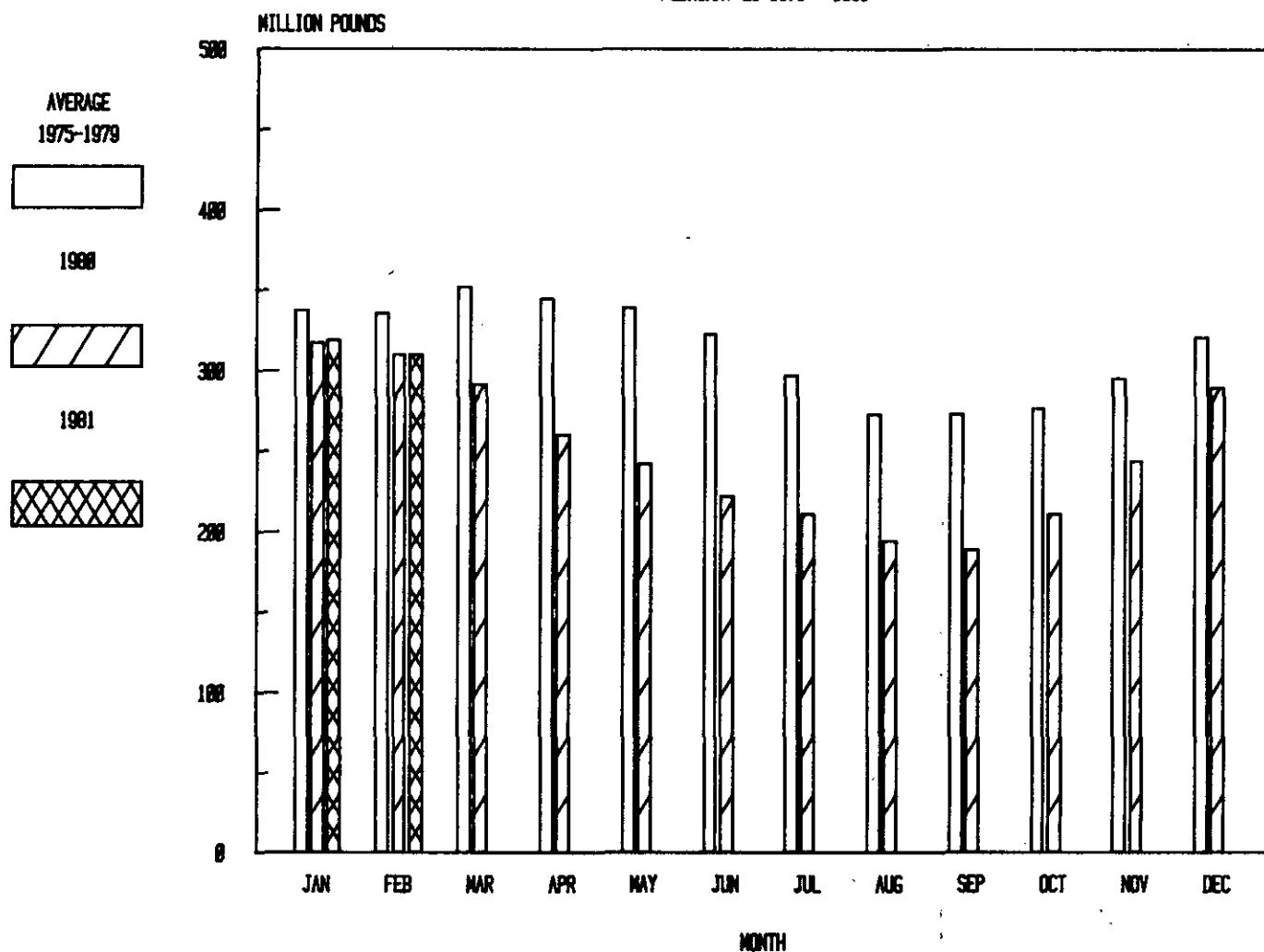
