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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MARCH 31, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on March 31 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, pork, fruits, juice concentrates, turkeys, and beef, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated milk, fresh fruits, shell eggs, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 1 percent from February 28 but were 11 percent more than the March 31, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 1 percent during the month and were 23 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 10 percent from last month and 22 percent above 1980.

Total juice concentrate holdings increased 12 percent from February 28 and were 9 percent above last year. Total frozen vegetables declined 12 percent during the month and were 17 percent below 1980. Total poundage of frozen fruits in freezers was down 10 percent from last month but up 13 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 60 percent of capacity, 2 points above February. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was unchanged from last month but 1 point below last year.

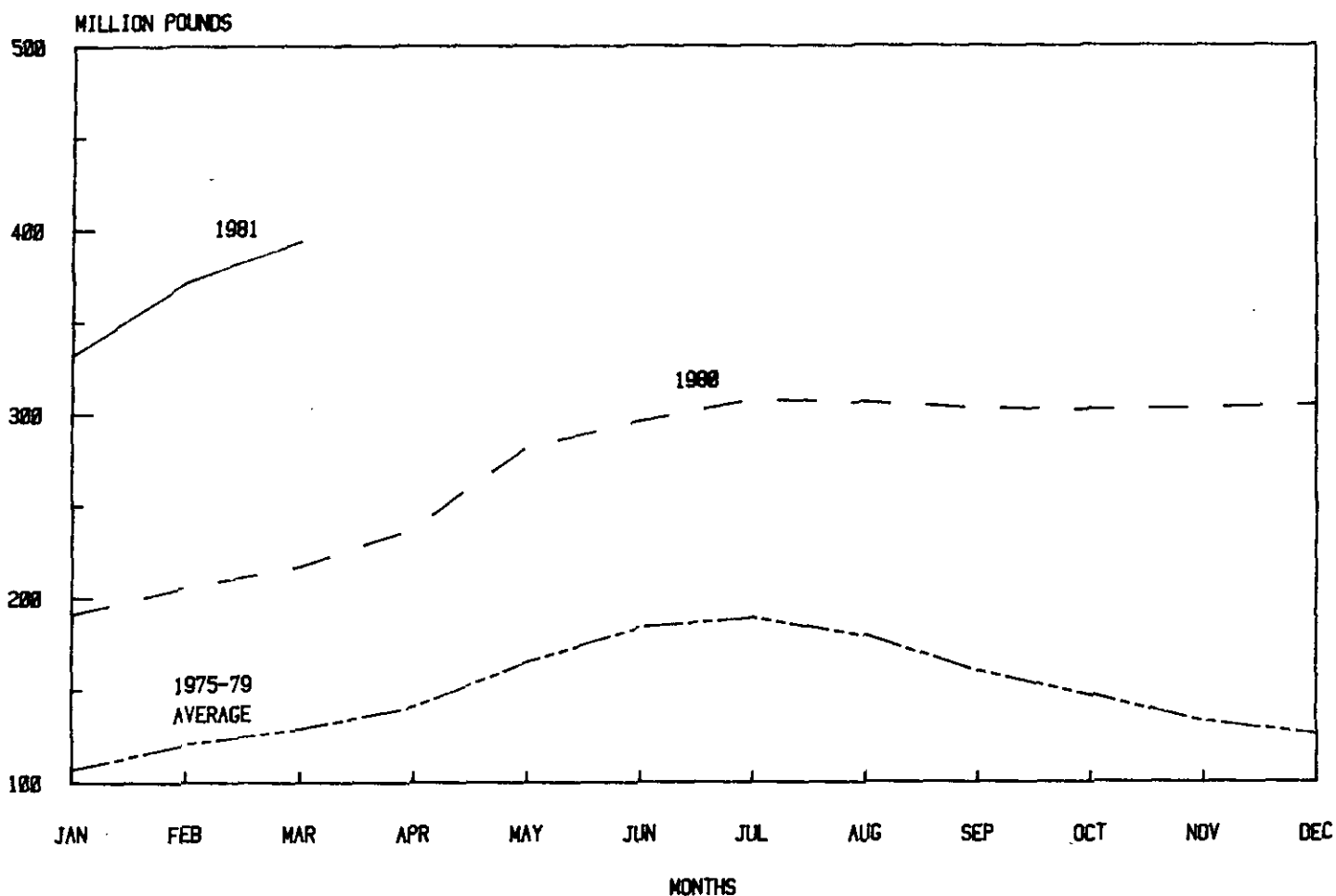
