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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, APRIL 30, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on April 30 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, pork, beef, turkeys, fruits, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated milk, fresh fruits, natural cheese and shell eggs.

Total red meats in freezers were 6 percent above March 31 and 14 percent above the April 30, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 13 percent during the month and were 18 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 20 percent from last month and were 27 percent above 1980.

Total natural cheese supplies increased 7 percent from March 31 and were 24 percent above last year. Butter stocks advanced 9 percent during the month and were 87 percent above 1980.

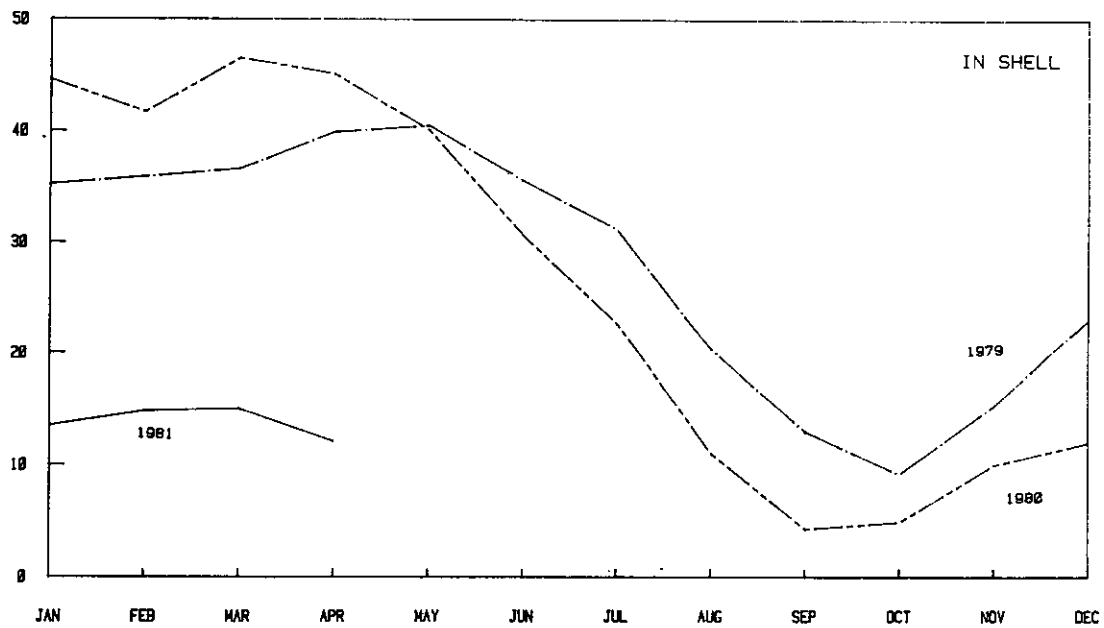
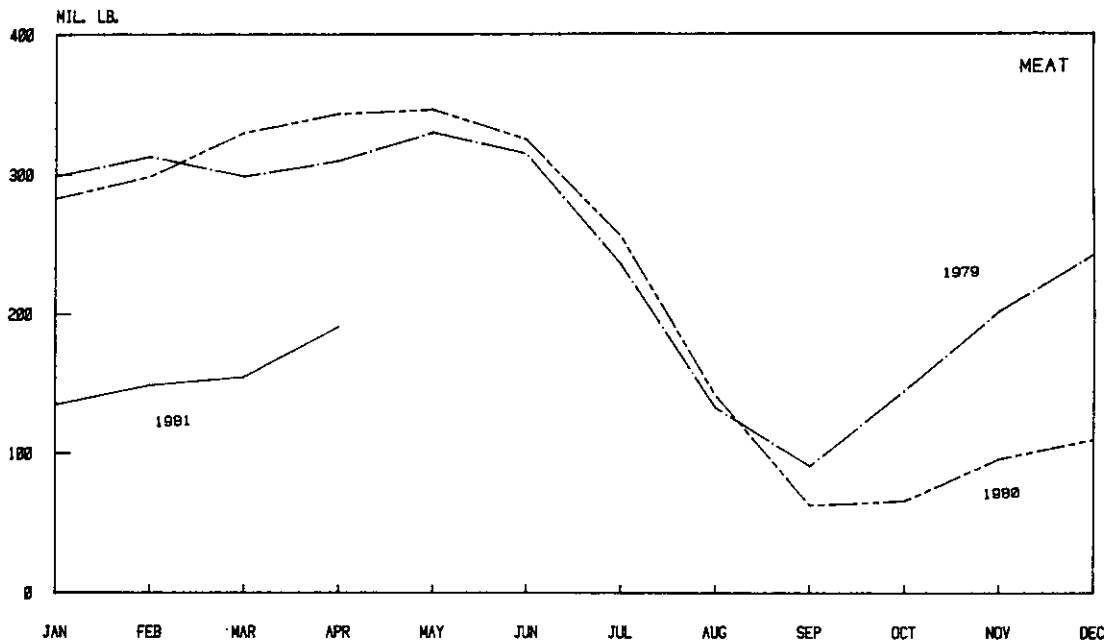
Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 61 percent of capacity, 1 point above March. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was 1 point below last month and last year.
