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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on May 31 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, beef, pork, fruits, turkeys, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated milk, fresh fruits, natural cheese, and fresh vegetables.

Total red meats in freezers declined 2 percent from April 30 but were 13 percent more than the May 31, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 2 percent during the month but were 11 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 6 percent from last month and were 24 percent above 1980.

Total butter holdings increased 5 percent from April 30 and were 68 percent above last year. Total American natural cheese advanced 3 percent during the month and was 26 percent above 1980.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 62 percent of capacity, 1 point above April. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was unchanged from last month and last year.

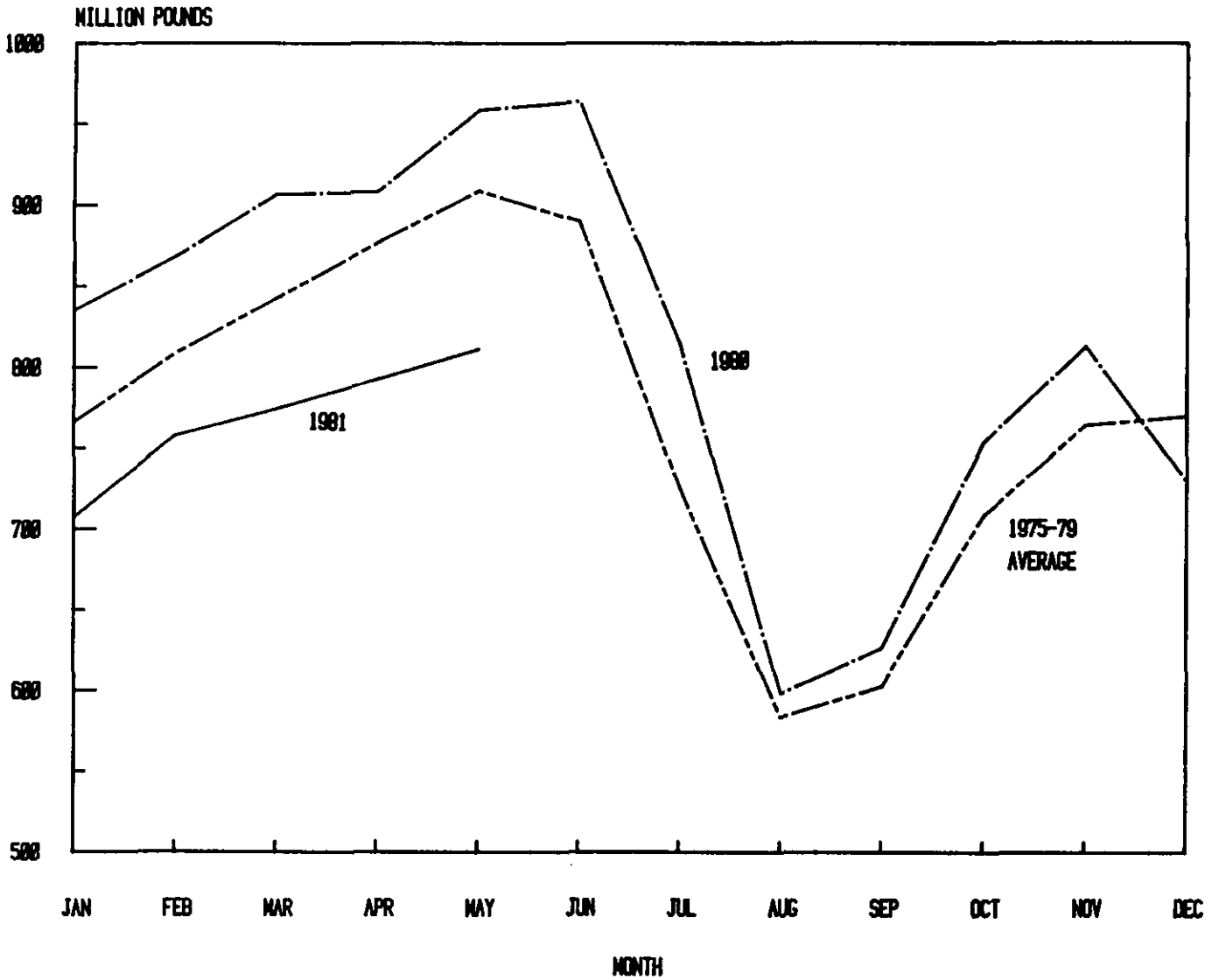
