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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JUNE 30, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on June 30 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, turkeys, beef, pork, chickens, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated milk, fresh vegetables, fresh fruits, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 9 percent from May 31 but were 12 percent more than the June 30, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 11 percent during the month but were 11 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 11 percent from last month but were 22 percent above 1980.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 20 percent from last month and were 9 percent above last year. Total stocks of chicken advanced 7 percent during the month and were 3 percent above 1980. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were 28 percent above last month and 14 percent above last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 62 percent of capacity, unchanged from May. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was 1 point above last month and last year.

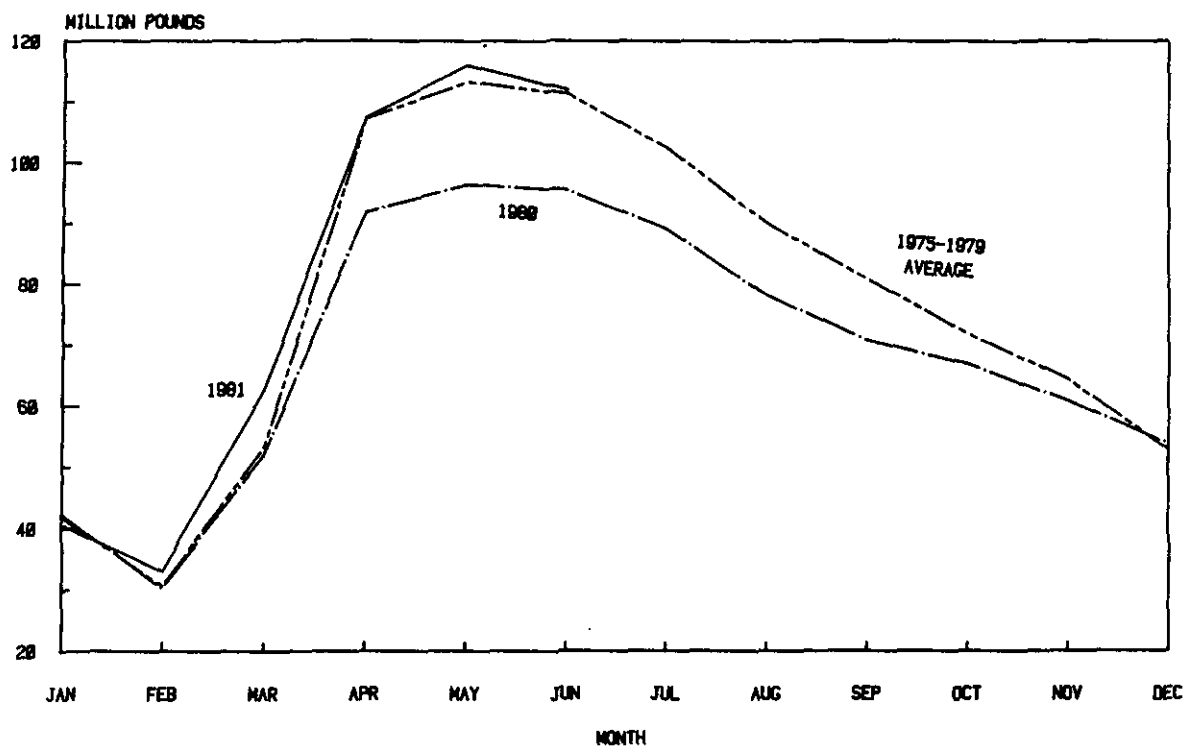
