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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JULY 31, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on July 31 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, turkeys, chickens, beef, pork, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh fruits, natural cheese, and shell eggs.

Total red meats in freezers declined 13 percent from June 30 but were 8 percent more than the July 31, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 19 percent during the month but were 7 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 38 percent from last month but were 6 percent above 1980.

Total frozen vegetable holdings increased 20 percent from June 30 but were 17 percent below last year. Total pounds of frozen fruits in freezers were up 30 percent from last month but down 5 percent from last year. Total juice concentrate stocks declined 12 percent during the month but were slightly above the previous year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 63 percent of capacity, 1 point above June. Public freezer occupancy at 69 percent was 1 point above last month and last year.

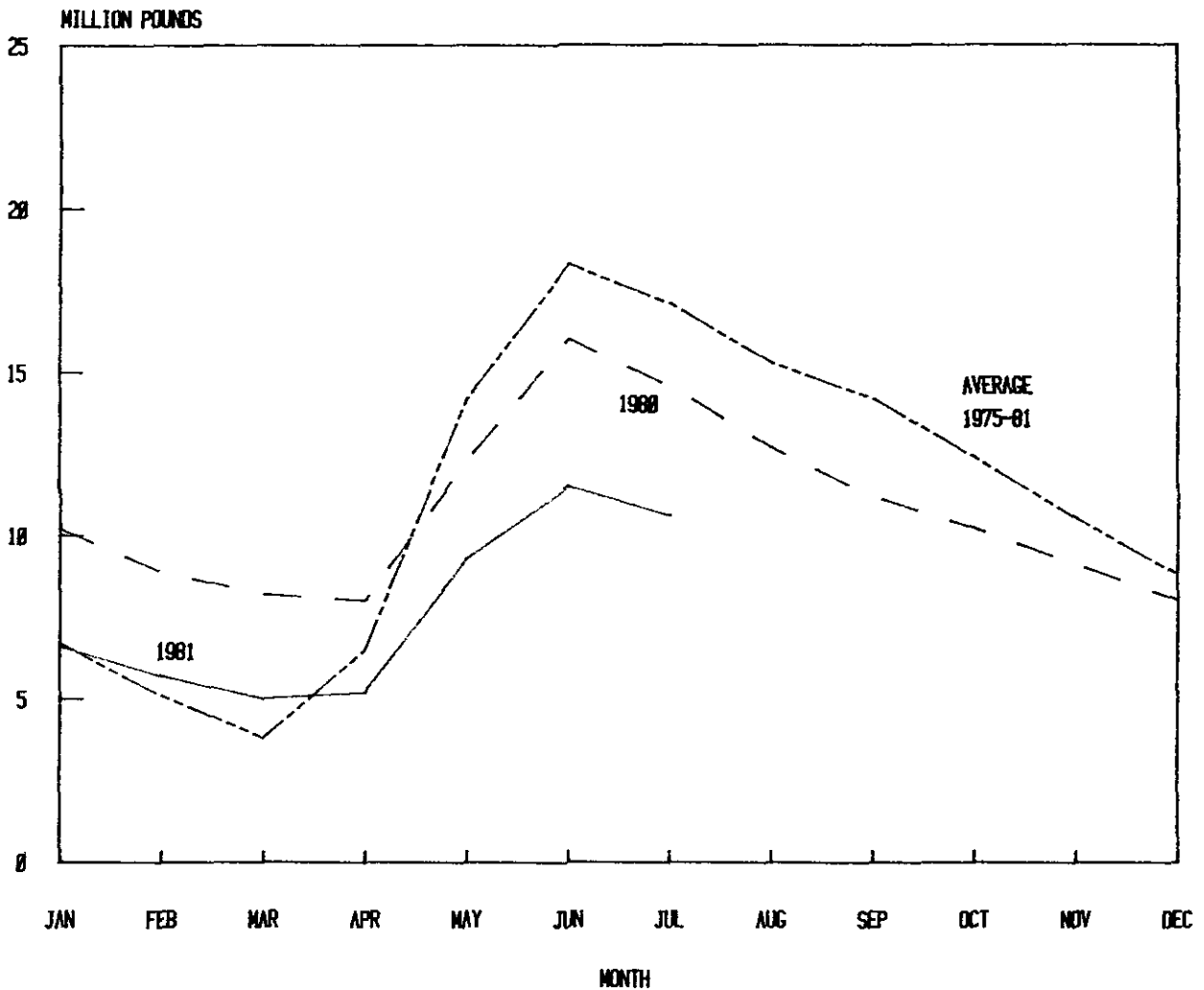
