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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, AUGUST 31, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on August 31 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, turkeys, chickens, beef, and pork, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included natural cheese and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 15 percent from July 31 but were 4 percent more than the August 31, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 21 percent during the month but were 3 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 50 percent from last month but were 5 percent above 1980.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 11 percent from July and were 20 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 4 percent during the month but were 17 percent above 1980. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 17 percent from last month and 23 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 65 percent of capacity, 2 points above July. Public freezer occupancy at 69 percent was unchanged from last month and last year.

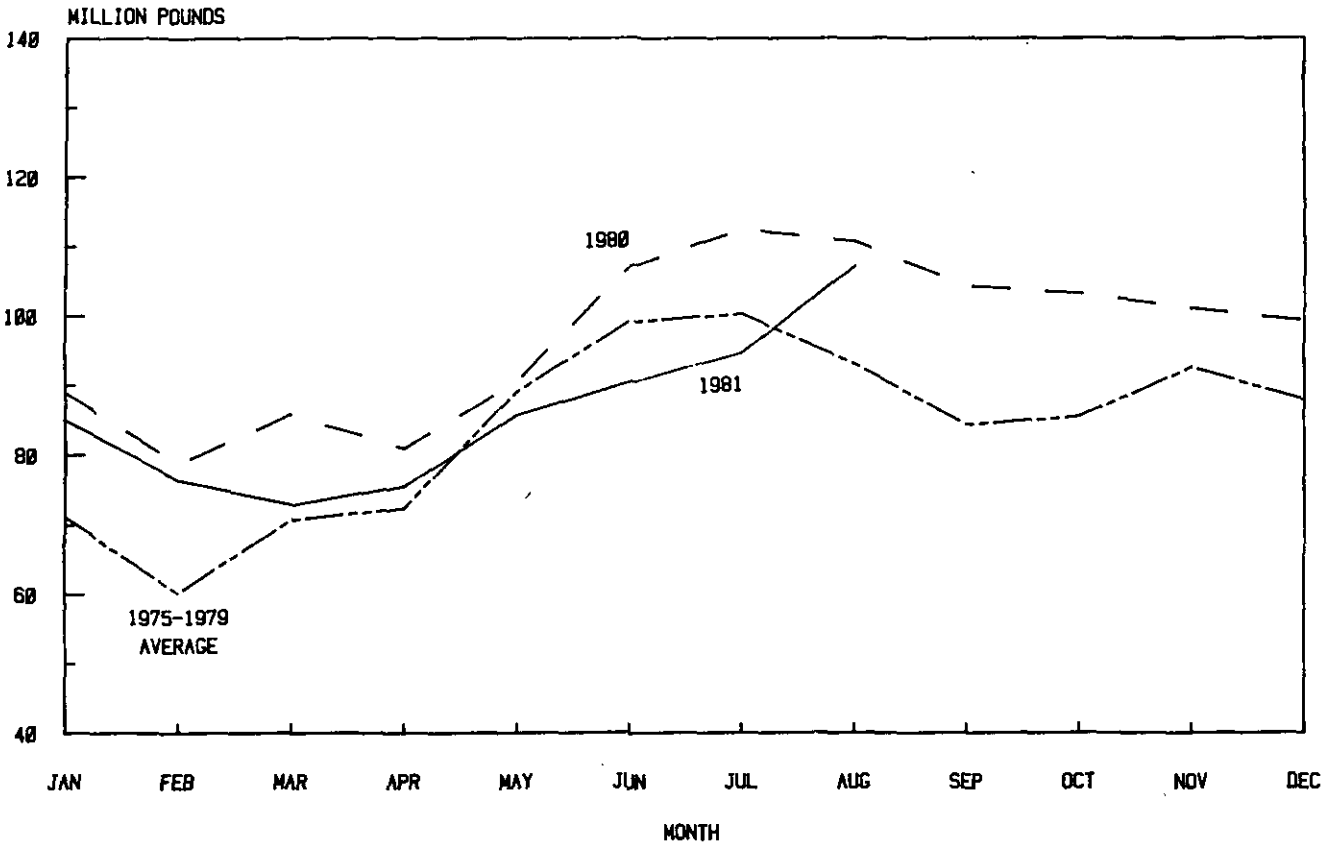
