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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, turkeys, chickens, potatoes, vegetables, juice concentrates, and beef, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 6 percent from August 31 and were 1 percent less than the September 30, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 8 percent during the month but were 7 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 55 percent from last month and were 26 percent below 1980.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 9 percent from August and were 28 percent above last year. Total stocks of turkeys advanced 14 percent during the month and were 33 percent above 1980. Total pounds of chickens in freezers were down 4 percent from last month but up 18 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 63 percent of capacity, 2 points below August. Public freezer occupancy at 72 percent was 3 points above last month and 1 point above last year.

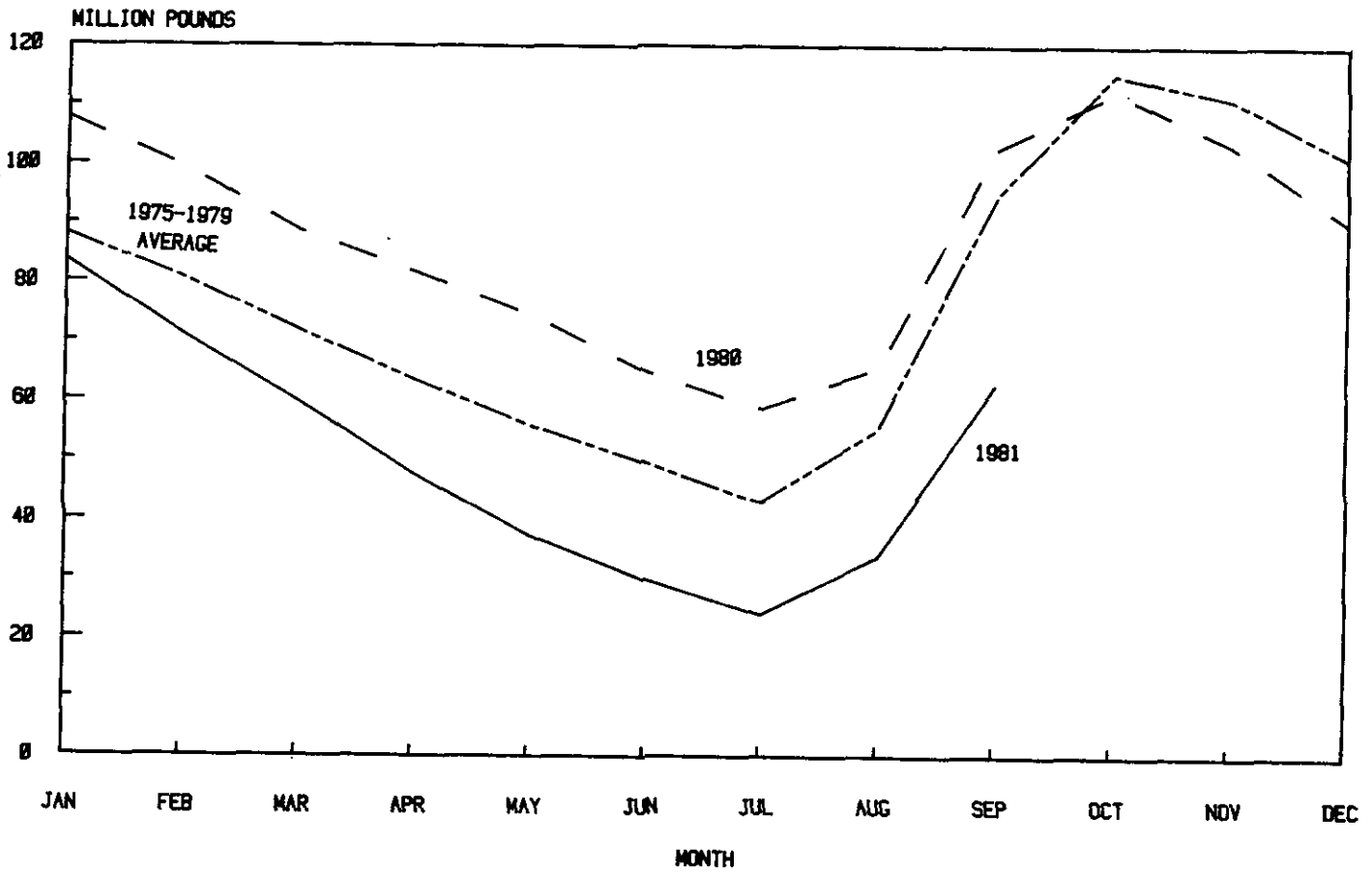
