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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, OCTOBER 31, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on October 31 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, turkeys, chickens, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, shell eggs, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers increased 6 percent from September 30 but were 8 percent less than the October 31, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 13 percent during the month but were 13 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 7 percent from last month but were 59 percent below 1980.

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 2 percent from September but were 21 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 4 percent during the month but were 13 percent above 1980. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 1 percent from last month but up 25 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 62 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 75 percent was 3 points above last month but unchanged from last year.
