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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, DECEMBER 31, 1981

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on December 31 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, turkeys, juice concentrates, and chickens, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, natural cheese, fresh vegetables and shell eggs.

Total red meats in freezers increased 5 percent from November 30 but were 22 percent less than the December 31, 1980 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 5 percent during the month but were 23 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 56 percent from last month but were 44 percent below the 1980 holdings.

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 16 percent from November but were 16 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 6 percent during the month but were 9 percent above 1980. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 21 percent from last month but up 21 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy at 64 percent of capacity was unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 71 percent was 2 points below last month but unchanged from last year.

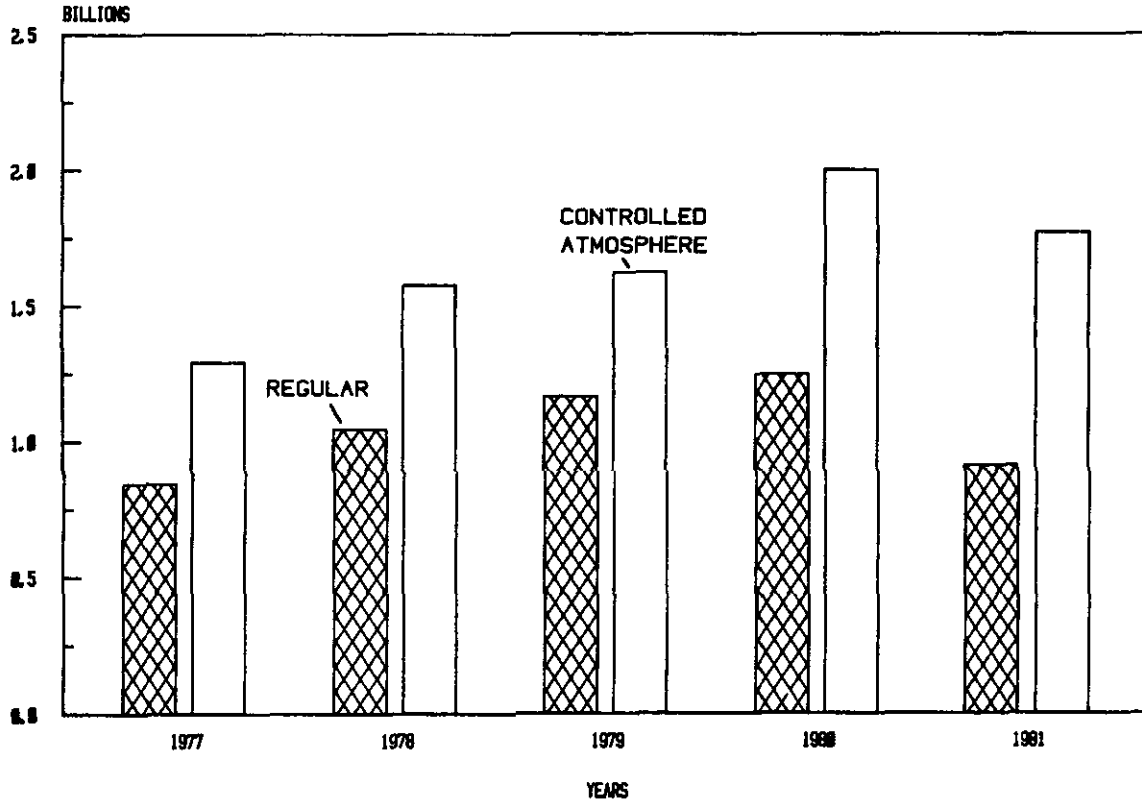
