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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JANUARY 31, 1982

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, turkeys, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 5 percent from December 1981 and were 30 percent less than the January 1981 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 6 percent during the month and were 29 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 16 percent from last month and were 49 percent below the 1981 holdings.

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 4 percent from December 1981 but were 4 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 9 percent during the month and were 10 percent above 1981. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were unchanged from last month and up 14 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 64 percent of capacity, one point below last month. Public freezer occupancy at 70 percent was unchanged from last month and one point above last year.

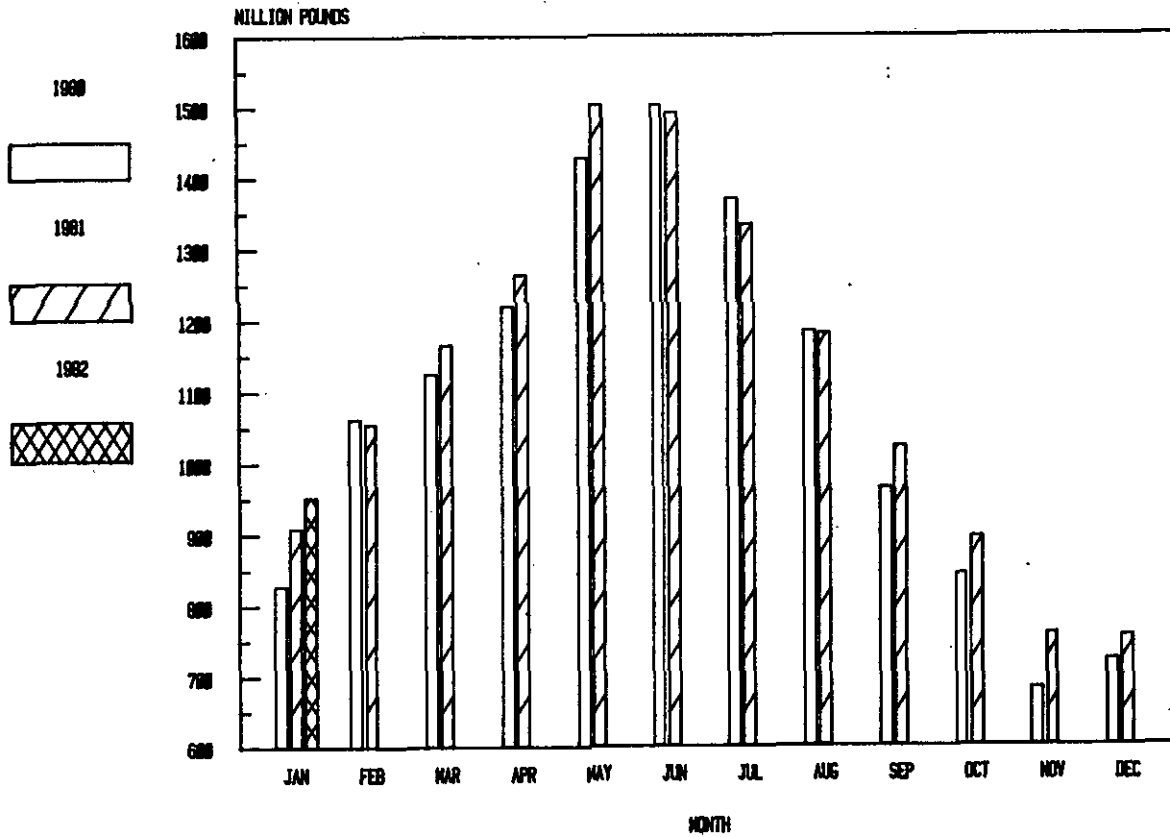
