

# COLD STORAGE

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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, FEBRUARY 28, 1982

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on February 28 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, turkeys, juice concentrates, and potatoes; according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, natural cheese, and shell eggs.

Total red meats in freezers declined 5 percent from January 1982 and were 33 percent less than the February 1981 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 1 percent during the month and were 31 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 9 percent from last month and were 56 percent below the 1981 holdings.

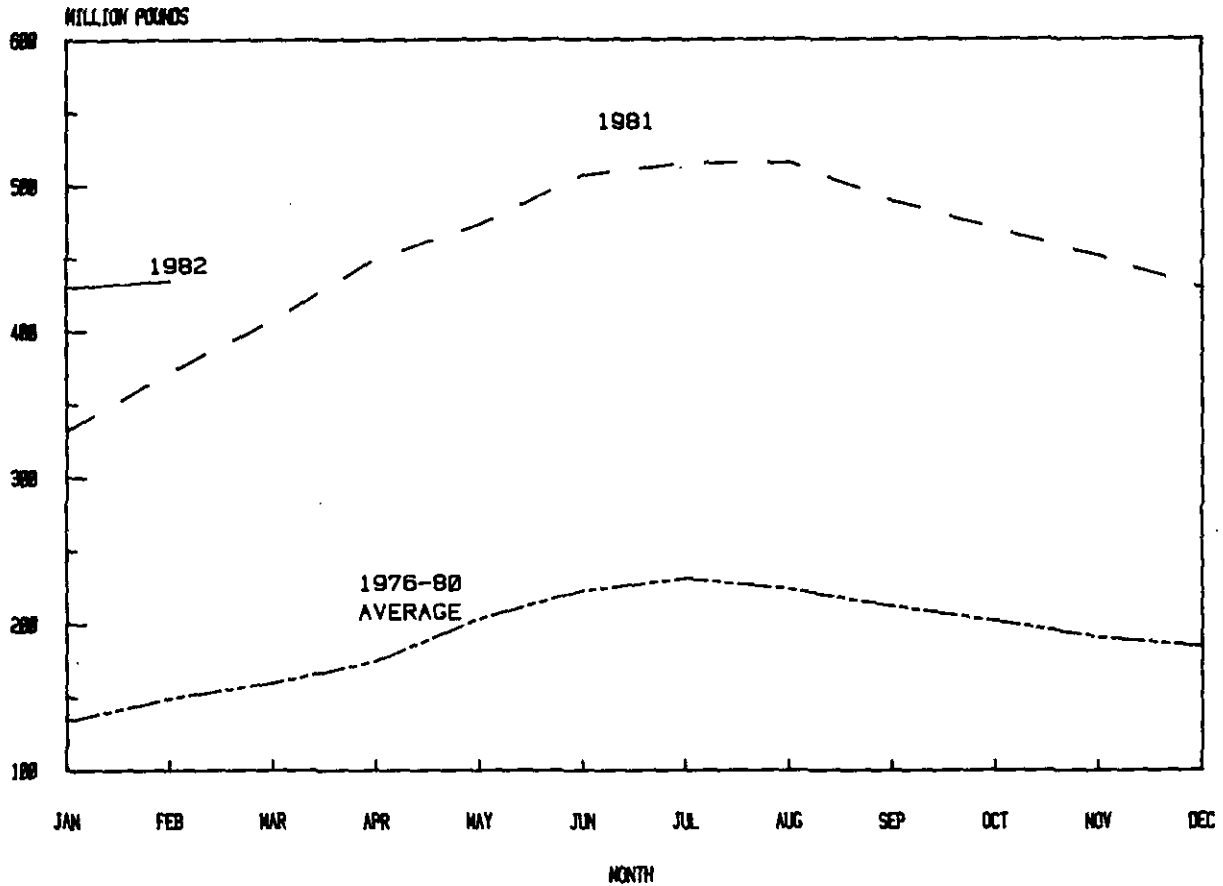

Data for this report are collected from public and private refrigerated warehouses storing commodities for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are excluded. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.

NOTE: The frequency of this report is being reduced from monthly to quarterly. The final monthly report will be released April 19, 1982 for stocks in refrigerated warehouses on March 31, 1982. The first quarterly report will be released July 19, 1982 for stocks in refrigerated warehouses on June 30, 1982.

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 1 percent from January 1982 but were 5 percent above last year. Total stocks of chicken declined 2 percent during the month and were 8 percent below 1981. Total pounds of turkey in freezers was unchanged from last month but up 14 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 64 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 69 percent was 1 point below last month but 1 point above last year.
