## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MARCH 31, 1982

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on March 31 were greater than year earlier levels for juice concentrates, butter, potatoes, and turkeys, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, shell eggs, natural cheese and fresh vegetables.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from February 1982 but were 31 percent less than the March 1981 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 11 percent during the month but were 24 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 56 percent from last month but were 37 percent below the 1981 holdings.

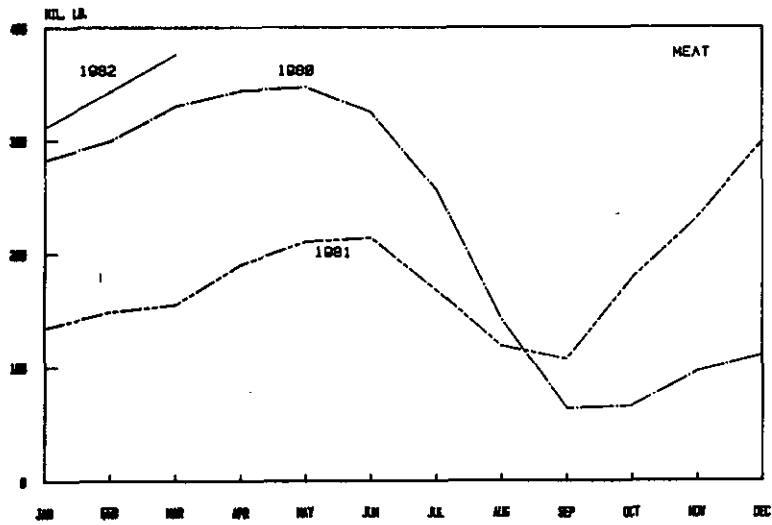

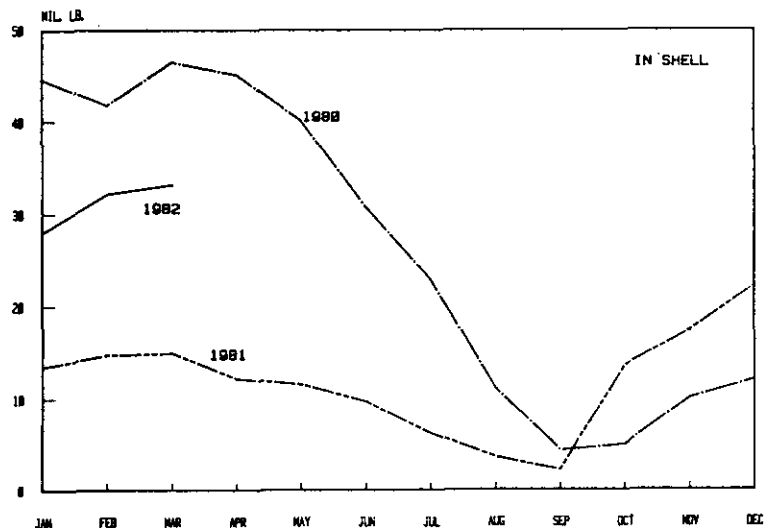

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 1 percent from February 1982 and were 1 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 5 percent during the month but were 7 percent below 1981. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 1 percent from last month but up 6 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 64 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was unchanged from last month and last year.
