COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JUNE 30, 1982

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on June 30 were greater than year earlier levels for potatoes, butter, vegetables, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated and condensed milk, nuts, fresh fruits, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 6 percent from March 1982 but were 30 percent less than the June 1981 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 3 percent during the quarter and were 24 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 10 percent from last quarter but were 38 percent below the 1981 holdings.

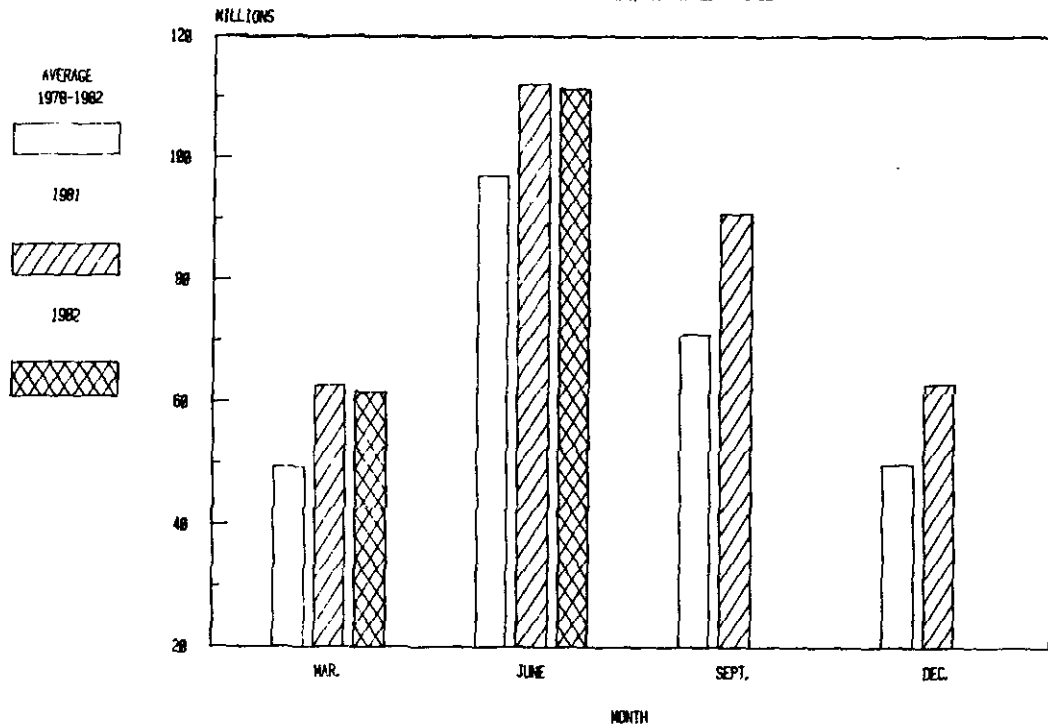

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 14 percent from March 1982 but were 16 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 8 percent during the quarter and were 27 percent below 1981. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 25 percent from last quarter but down 11 percent from last year.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 64 percent of capacity, 1 point above last quarter. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was 1 point above last quarter but equal to last year.
