

# COLD STORAGE

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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, DECEMBER 31, 1982

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on December 31, were greater than year earlier levels for vegetables, eggs, beef, fruits, potatoes, butter, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated and condensed milk, natural cheese, fresh vegetables, dried and evaporated fruits, and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers increased 20 percent from September 1982 but were 2 percent less than the December 1982 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 23 percent during the quarter but were 15 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 315 percent from last quarter but 43 percent below 1982.

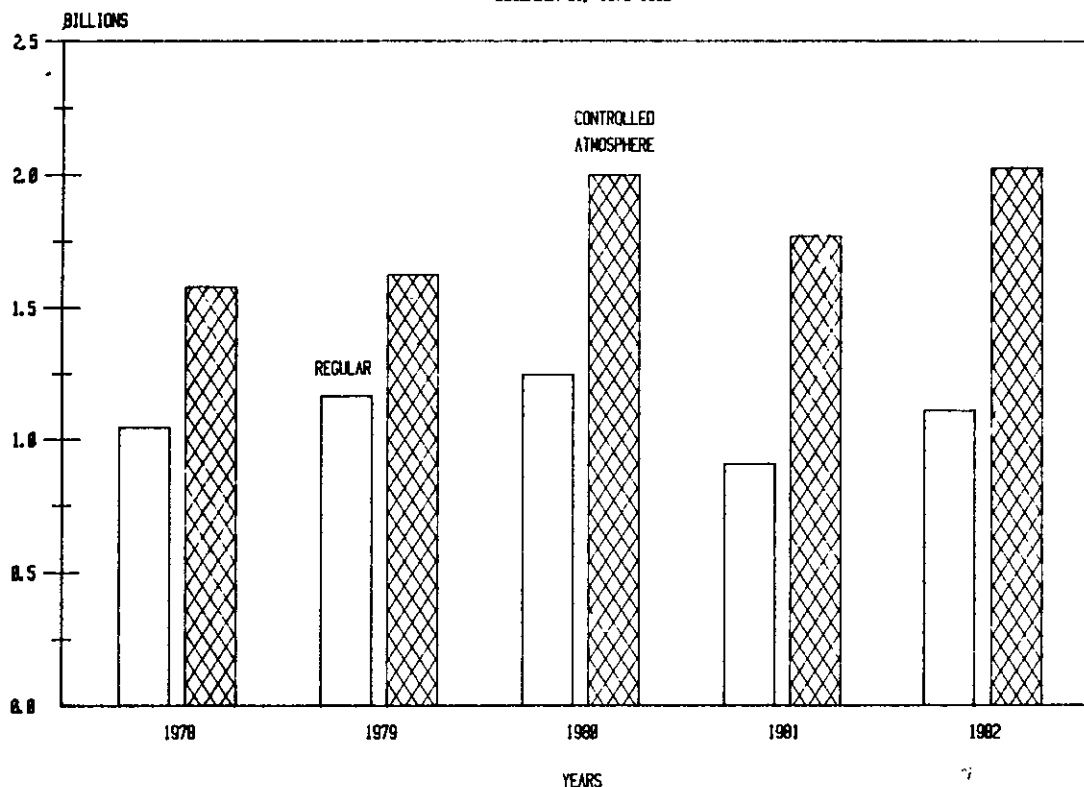

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 39 percent from September 1982 and were 12 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 10 percent during the quarter but were 10 percent below 1982. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was down 53 percent from last quarter and down 14 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 63 percent of capacity, 3 point below last quarter. Public freezer occupancy at 72 percent was 3 points below last quarter but 2 points above last year.
