COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JANUARY 31, 1983

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31, 1983 were greater than year earlier levels for vegetables, eggs, beef, potatoes, butter, fruits, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, evaporated and condensed milk, natural cheese, shell eggs, fresh fruits, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers increased 3 percent from December 1982 and were 3 percent more than the January 1982 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 2 percent during the month but were 10 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 7 percent from last month but were 28 percent below January 1982.

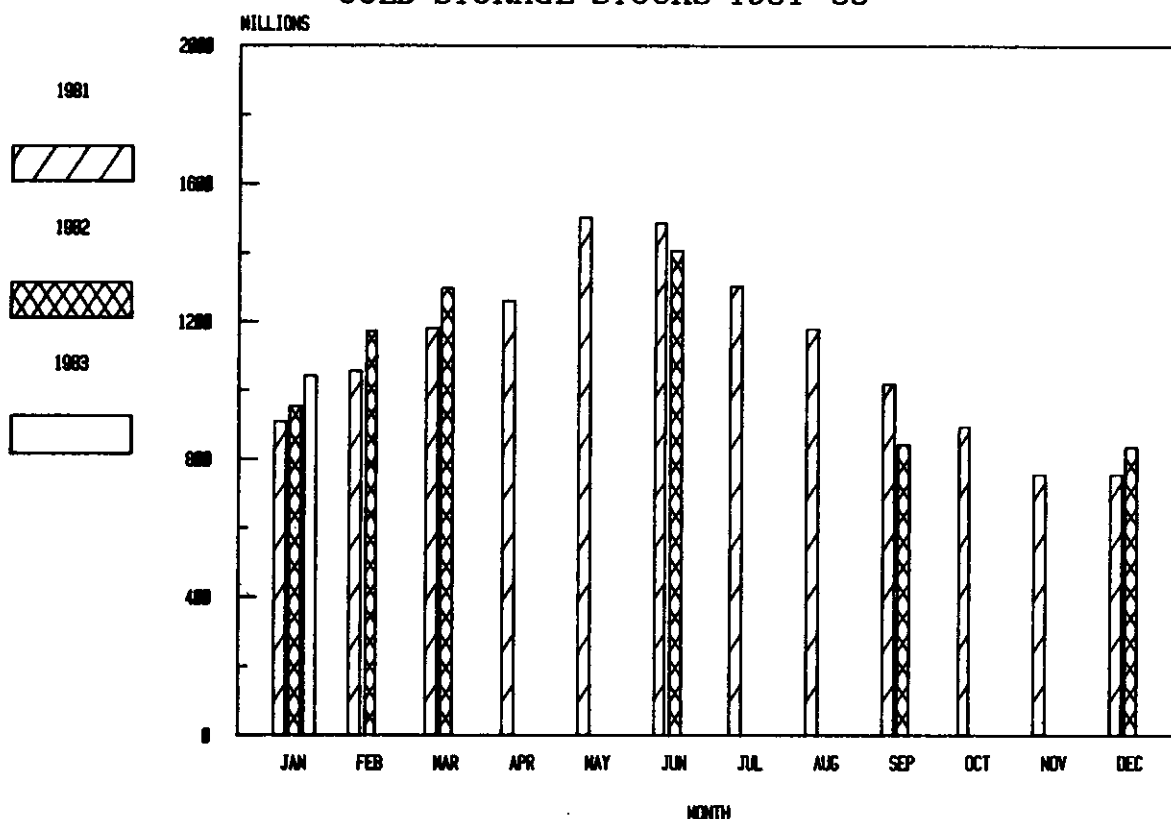

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 4 percent from December 1982 and were 12 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 5 percent during the month and were 6 percent below January 1982. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was down 3 percent from last month and down 16 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 62 percent of capacity, 2 points below last month. Public freezer occupancy at 72 percent was 1 point below last month but 3 points above last year.
