## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, FEBRUARY 28, 1983

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on February 28 were greater than year earlier levels for eggs, beef, vegetables, butter, potatoes and fruits, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated and condensed milk, natural cheese, fresh vegetables, shell eggs, fresh fruits, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 1 percent from January 1983 but were 8 percent more than the February 1982 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 4 percent during the month and were 13 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were unchanged from last month but were 20 percent below 1982.

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 5 percent from January 1983 and were 16 percent below last year. Total stocks of chicken declined 8 percent during the month and were 10 percent below 1982. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 3 percent from last month and down 20 percent from last year.

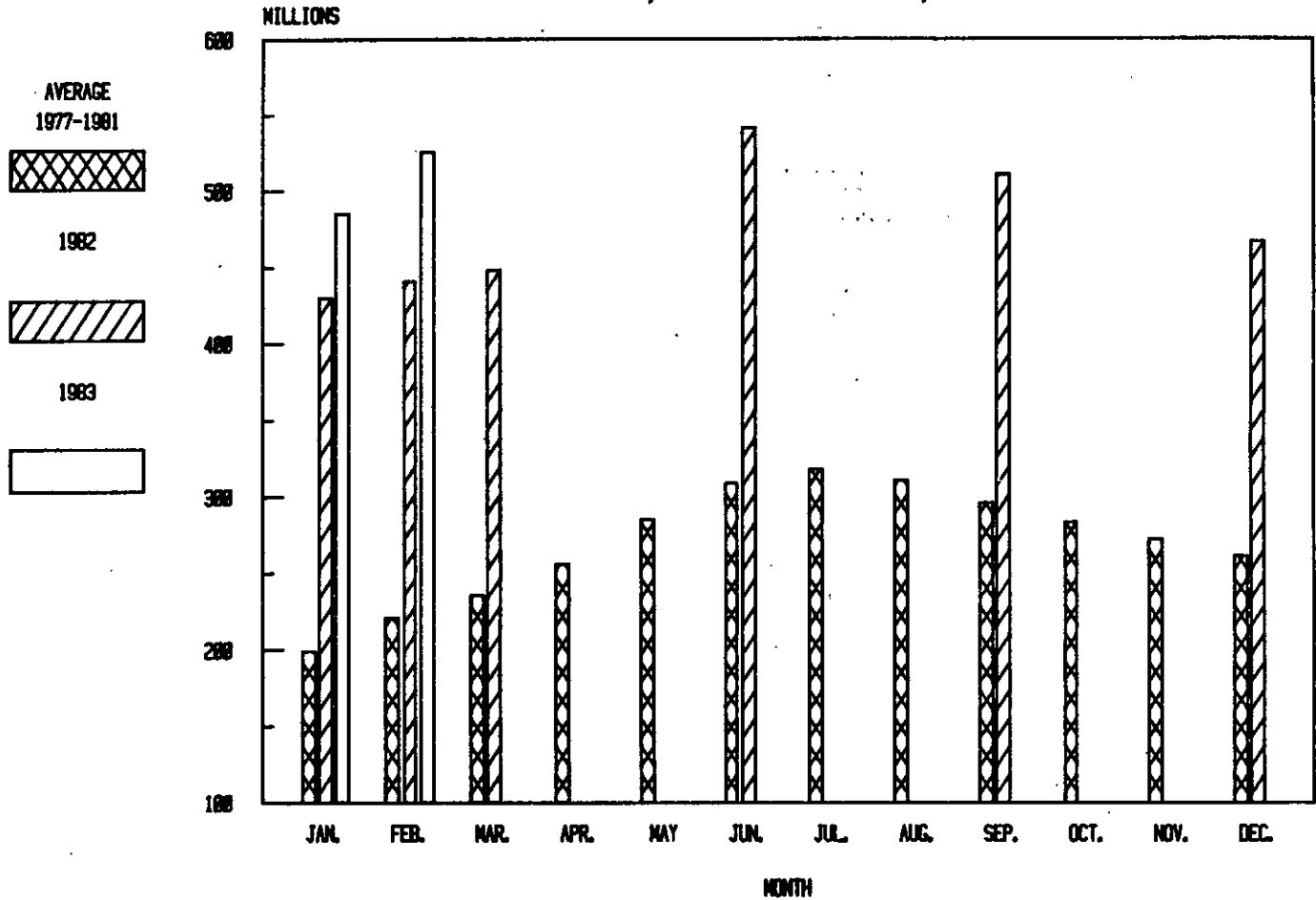
Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 64 percent of capacity, 1 point above last month. Public freezer occupancy at 70 percent was 2 points below last month but 1 point above last year.
