COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MARCH 31, 1983

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on March 31 were greater than year earlier levels for beef, eggs, vegetables, butter, fruits and potatoes, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated and condensed milk, fresh vegetables, natural cheese, fresh fruits, dried and evaporated fruits and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from February 1983 and were 8 percent more than the March 1982 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 9 percent during the month but were 14 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 33 percent from last month but were 33 percent below the 1982 holdings.

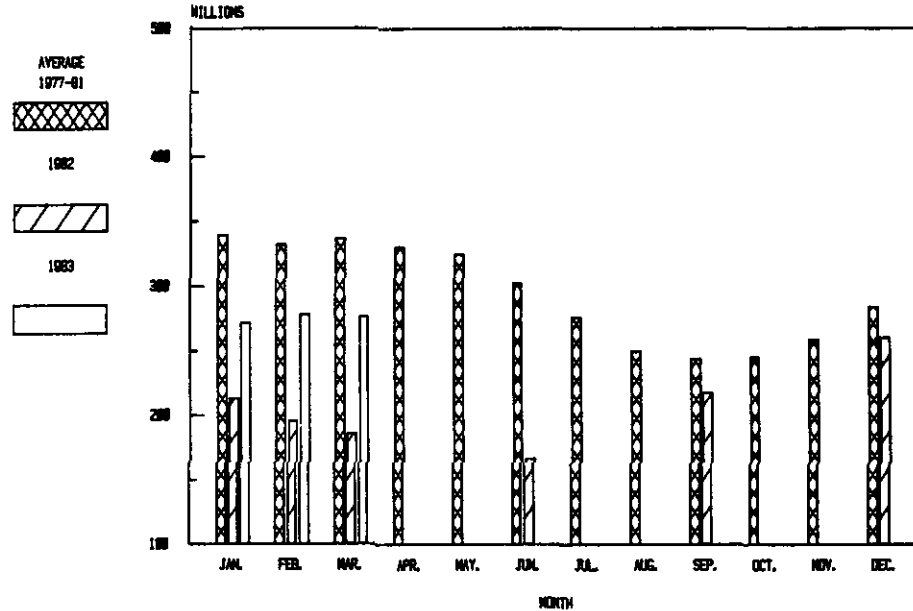

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 4 percent from February 1983 but were 14 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 15 percent during the month but were 2 percent below 1982. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was down 3 percent from last month and down 22 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy at 64 percent of capacity, was unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was 2 points below last month but 1 point above last year.
