COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, APRIL 30, 1983

Publication of the Cold Storage Report has been reinstated on a monthly basis for 1983. Comparative data with 1982 are not available for the months of April, May, July, August, October, and November.

Total red meats in freezers on April 30, 1983 increased 4 percent from March 1983. Frozen pork stocks rose 17 percent during the month and stocks of pork bellies were up 21 percent from March 1983.

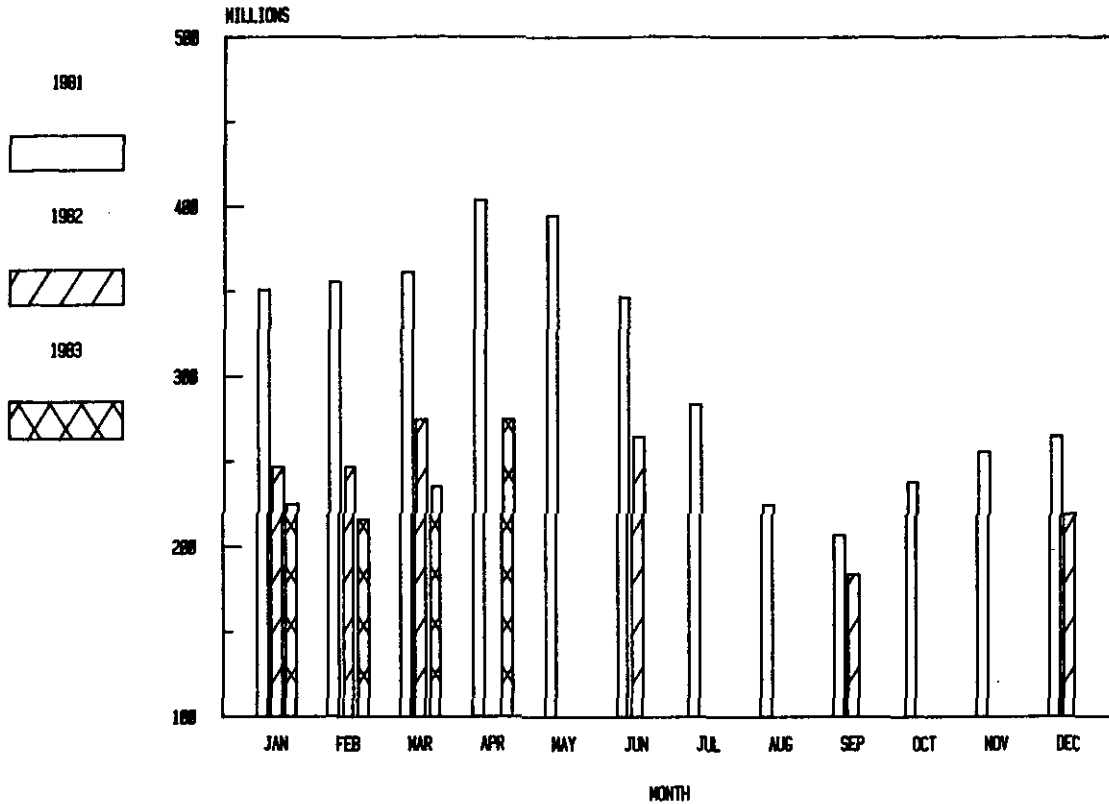

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 6 percent from March 1983. Total stocks of chickens advanced 8 percent during the month while total pounds of turkeys in freezers rose 3 percent.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 62 percent of capacity, 2 points below last month. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent declined 1 point during the month.
