COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1983

Publication of the Cold Storage Report has been reinstated on a monthly basis for 1983. Comparative data with 1982 are not available for the months of April, May, July, August, October, and November.

Total red meats in freezers on May 31, 1983 increased 2 percent from April 1983. Frozen pork stocks rose 8 percent during the month and stocks of pork bellies were up 19 percent from April 1983.

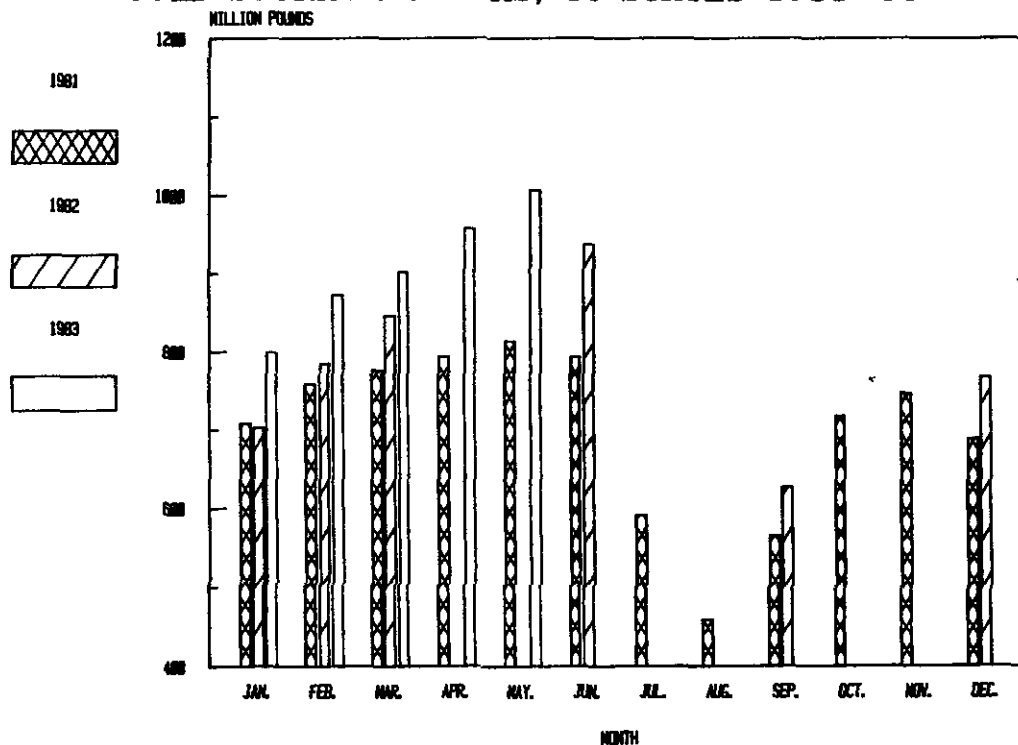

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 4 percent from April 1983. Total stocks of chickens declined 3 percent during the month while total pounds of turkeys in freezers rose 9 percent.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 63 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent declined 1 point during the month.
