COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JUNE 30, 1983

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on June 30 were greater than year earlier levels for beef, fruits, vegetables, chickens, butter, potatoes, pork, and eggs, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included vegetables, natural cheese, shell eggs, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 3 percent from May 1983 but were 18 percent more than the June 1982 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 5 percent during the month but were 6 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 2 percent from last month and were 13 percent below the 1982 holdings.

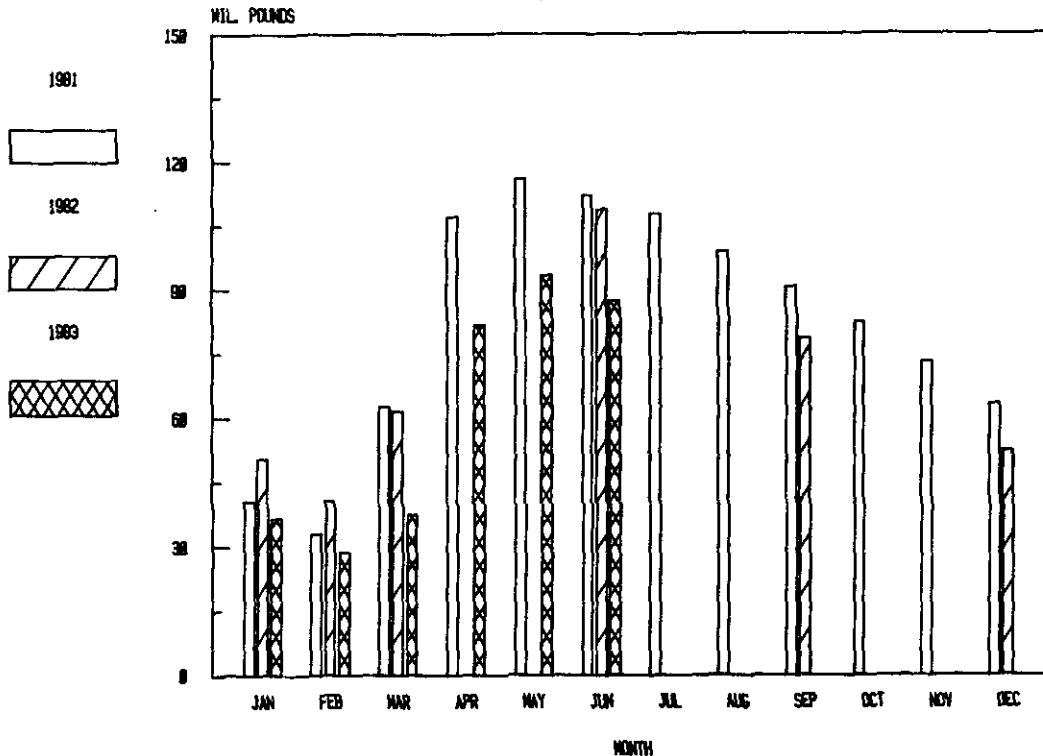

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 15 percent from May 1983 but were 3 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 7 percent during the month and were 12 percent above 1982. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 20 percent from last month but down 10 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 64 percent of capacity, 1 point above last month. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was 1 point above last month and 1 point above last year.
