## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JULY 31, 1983

Publication of the Cold Storage report has been reinstated on a monthly basis for 1983. Comparative data with 1982 are not available for the months of April, May, July, August, October, and November.

Total red meats in freezers on July 31, 1983 declined 4 percent from June 1983. Frozen pork stocks declined 10 percent during the month and stocks of pork bellies declined 24 percent.

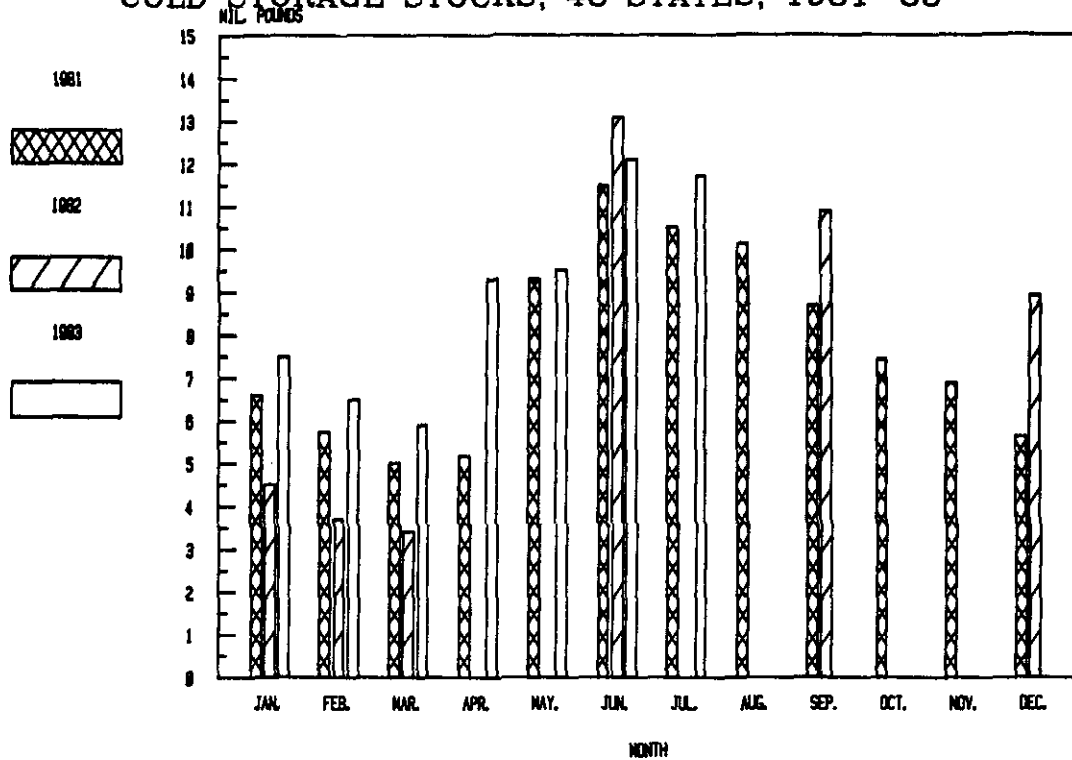

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 16 percent from June 1983. Stocks of chickens were unchanged while total pounds of turkeys in freezers rose 25 percent.

**OCCUPANCY:** Public cooler occupancy was at 65 percent of capacity, up 1 percent from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 69 percent rose 1 point during the month.
