COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, AUGUST 31, 1983

Publication of the Cold Storage report has been reinstated on a monthly basis for 1983. Comparative data with 1982 are not available for the months of April, May, July, August, October, and November.

Total red meats in freezers on August 31, 1983 declined 6 percent from July 1983. Frozen pork stocks declined 16 percent during the month while total frozen beef rose 4 percent. Pork bellies declined 46 percent.

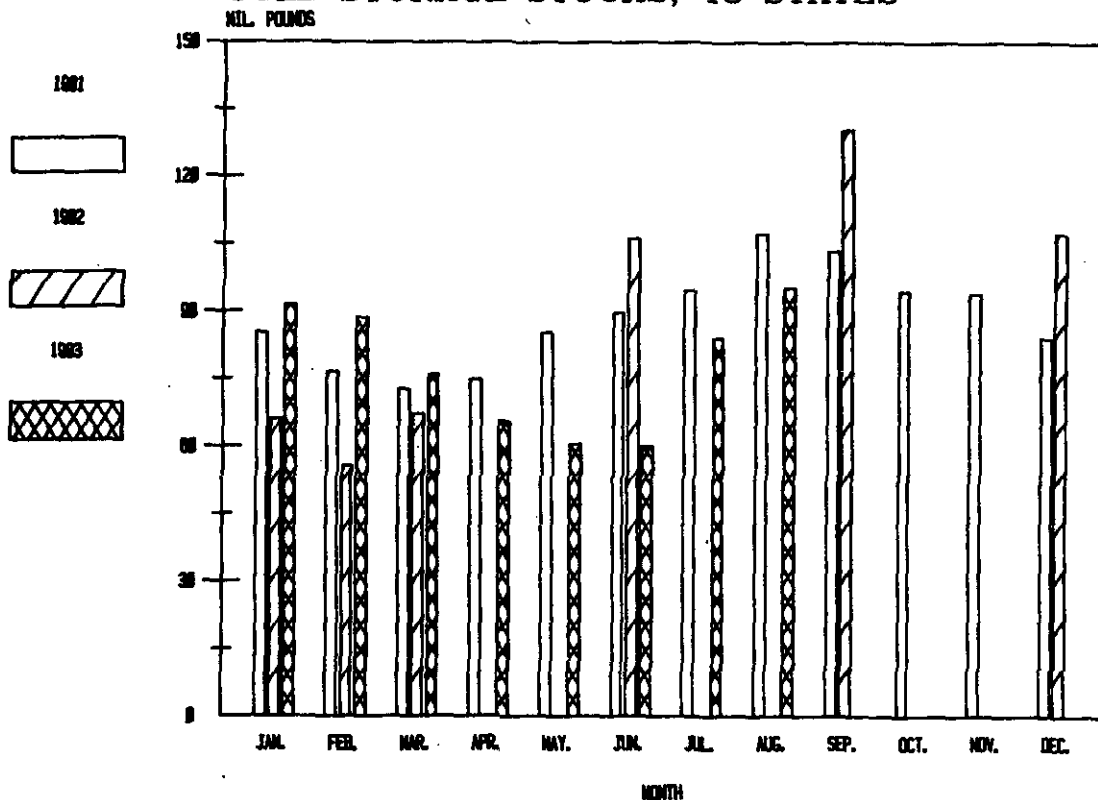

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 11 percent from July 1983. Stocks of chickens declined 7 percent during the month while total pounds of turkeys in freezers rose 20 percent.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 65 percent of capacity, down 1 point from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 70 percent increased 1 point during the month.
