COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, NOVEMBER 30, 1983

Publication of the Cold Storage report has been reinstated on a monthly basis for 1983. Comparative data for 1982 are not available for the months of April, May, July, August, October, and November.

Supplies of red meats in freezers on November 30, 1983 increased 15 percent from October 1983. Frozen pork stocks increased 22 percent during the month while total frozen beef rose 13 percent. Supplies of pork bellies increased 165 percent.

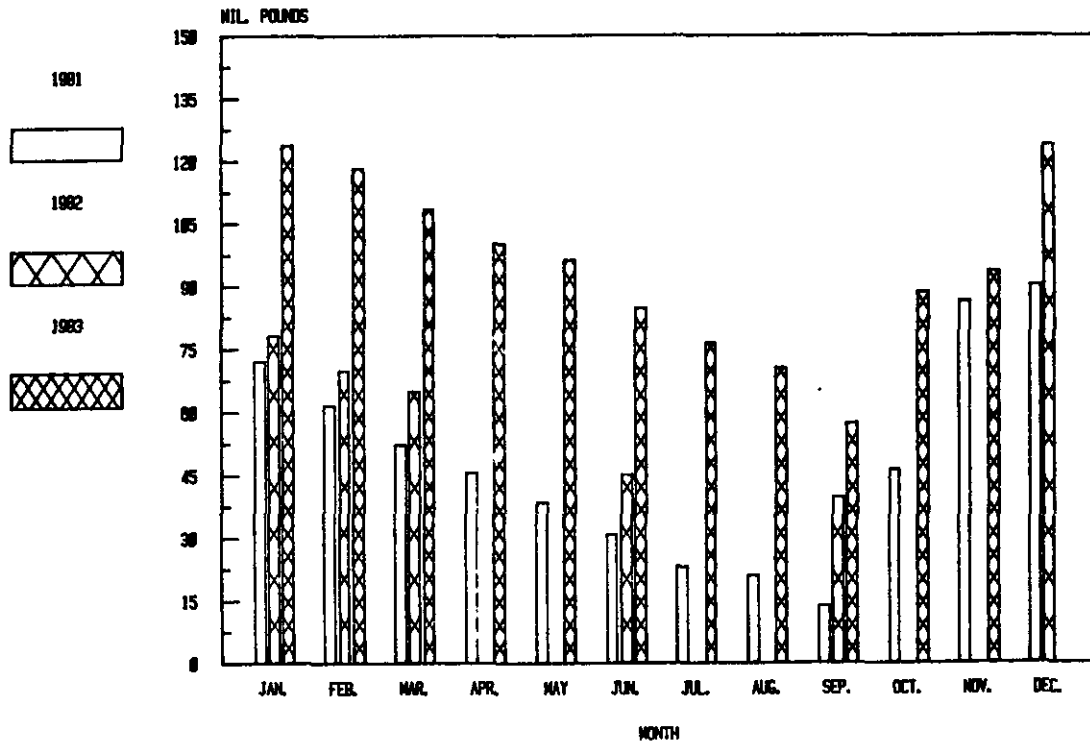

Total frozen poultry supplies dropped 38 percent from October 1983. Stocks of chickens declined 11 percent during the month while total pounds of turkeys in freezers declined 46 percent.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 66 percent of capacity, up 2 points from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 74 percent, decreased 1 point during the month.
