## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, DECEMBER 31, 1983

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on December 31 were greater than year earlier levels for pork, beef, butter, fruits, and potatoes, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included natural cheese, and evaporated and condensed milk

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from November 1983 and were 23 percent more than the December 1982 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 2 percent during the month and were 37 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 49 percent from last month and were 151 percent above the 1982 holdings.

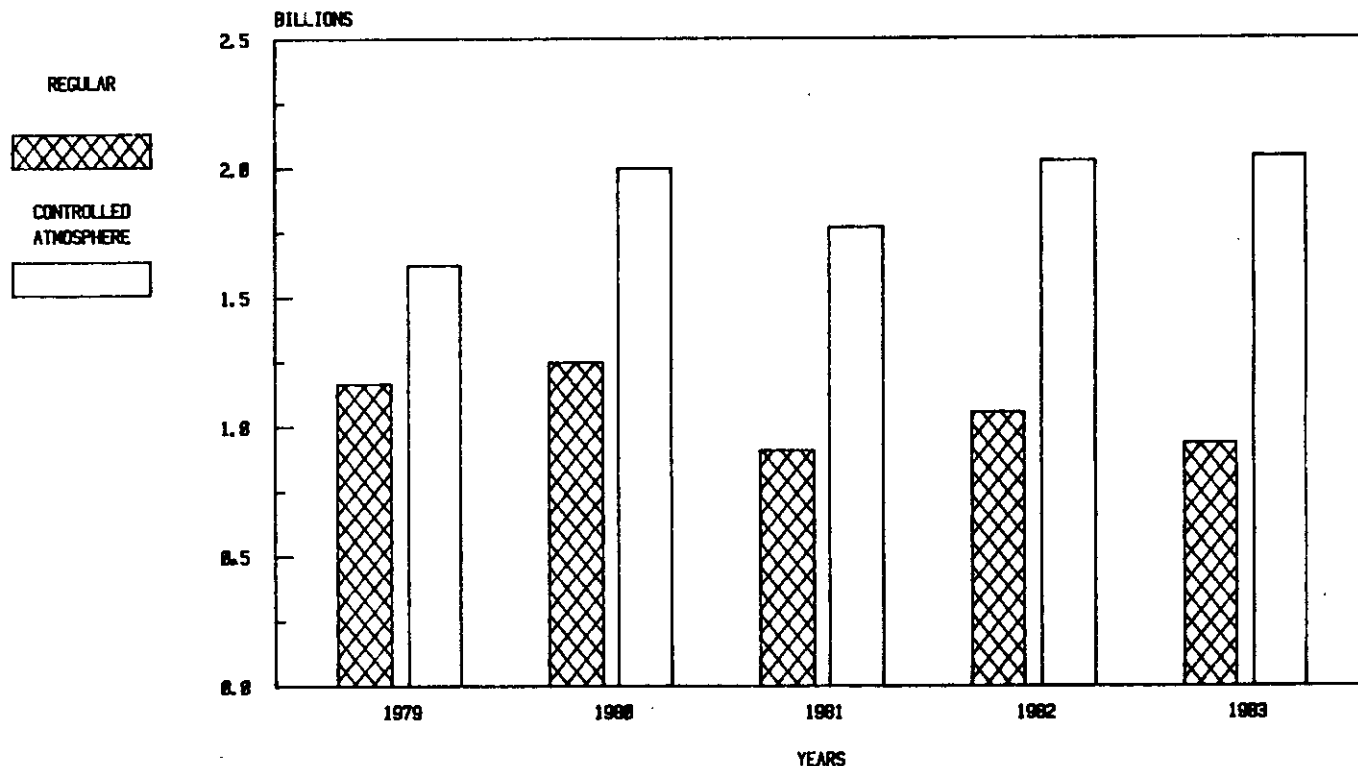

## FRESH APPLES IN COLD STORAGE

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 25 percent from November 1983 and were 18 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 6 percent during the month and were 17 percent below 1982. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 35 percent from last month and down 20 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 66 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 71 percent was 3 points below last month and 2 points below last year.
