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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, FEBRUARY 29, 1984

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on February 29 were greater than year earlier levels for pork, fruits, beef, and butter, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included natural cheese, and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from January 1984 and were 22 percent more than the February 1983 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 6 percent during the month and were 44 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 9 percent from last month and were 134 percent above the 1983 holdings.

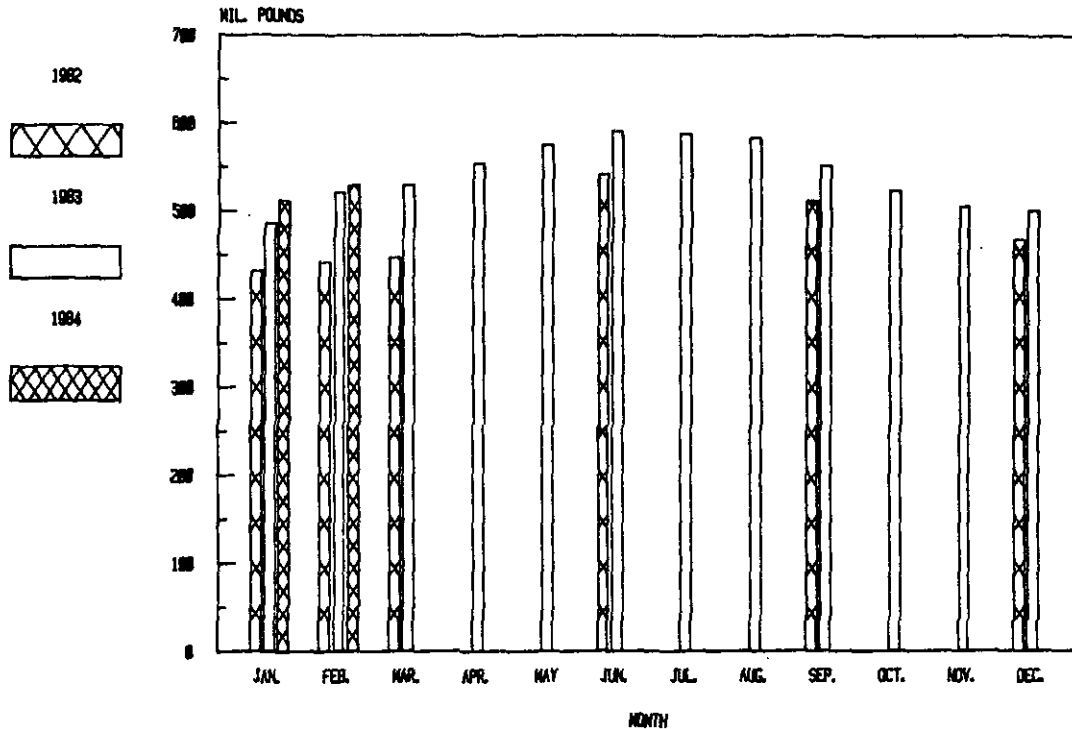

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 8 percent from January 1984 and were 19 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 7 percent during the month and were 14 percent below 1983. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 9 percent from last month and down 22 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 64 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 67 percent, was 2 points below last month and 3 points below last year.
