COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, APRIL 30, 1984

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on April 30 were greater than year earlier levels for pork, beef, and fruits, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs, fresh fruits, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers increased 5 percent from March 1984 and were 28 percent more than the April 1983 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 11 percent during the month and were 42 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 18 percent from last month and were 105 percent above the 1983.

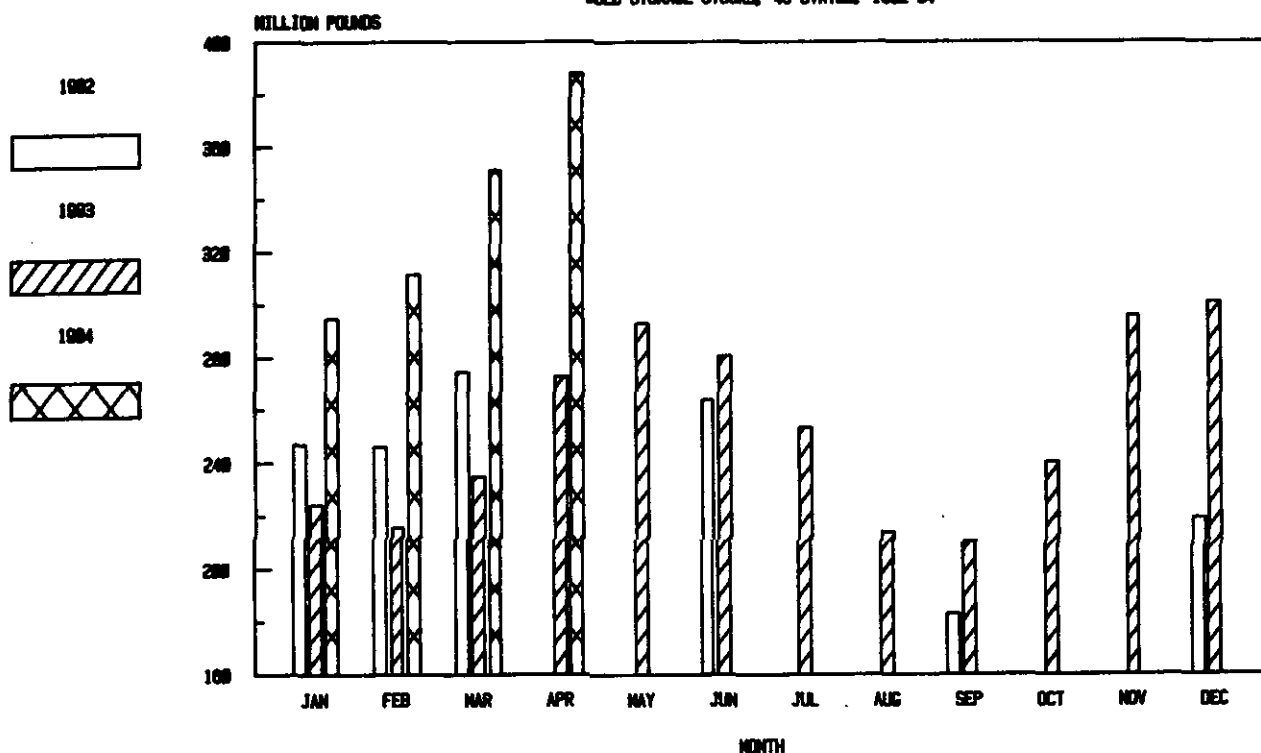

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 2 percent from March 1984 but were 21 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 11 percent during the month but were 13 percent below 1983. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 5 percent from last month and down 26 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 64 percent of capacity, 1 point above last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 65 percent, was 1 point below last month and 3 points below last year.
