COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1984

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on May 31 were greater than year earlier levels for pork, beef, and fruits, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs, natural cheese, and evaporated and condensed milk.

Total red meats in freezers increased 4 percent from April 1984 and were 31 percent more than the May 1983 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 13 percent during the month and were 50 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 14 percent from last month and were 97 percent above the 1983 holdings.

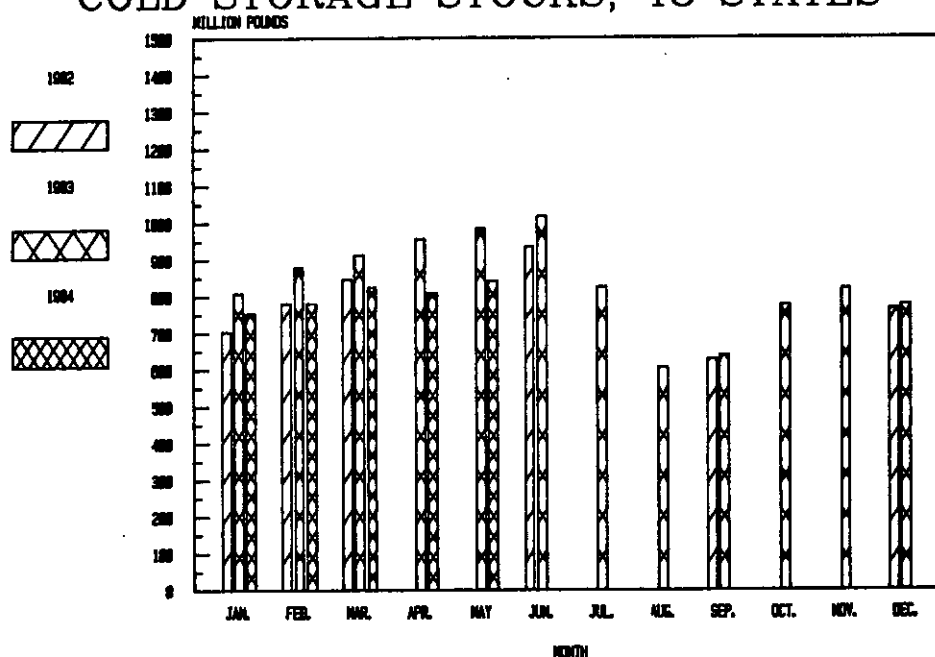

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 14 percent from April 1984 but were 13 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 2 percent during the month and were 9 percent below 1983. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 27 percent from last month but down 14 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 63 percent of capacity, 1 point below last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 64 percent, was unchanged from last month but 3 points below last year.
