COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JUNE 30, 1984

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on June 30 were greater than year earlier levels for pork and beef, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh fruits, evaporated and condensed milk and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 5 percent from May 1984 but were 31 percent more than the May 1983 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 7 percent during the month but were 45 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 10 percent from last month but were 81 percent above the 1983 holdings.

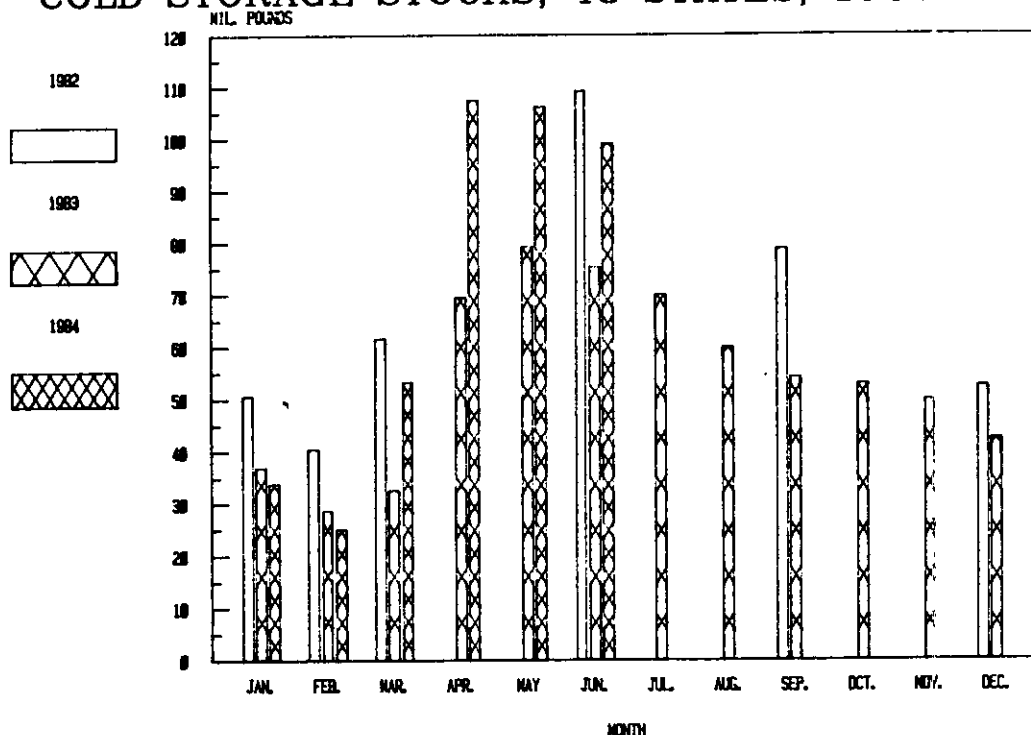

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 17 percent from May 1984 but were 13 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 4 percent during the month but were 15 percent below 1983. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 25 percent from last month but down 11 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 61 percent of capacity, 2 points below last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 64 percent, was unchanged from last month but 4 points below last year.
