COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JULY 31, 1984

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on July 31 were greater than year earlier levels for pork, beef, fruits, and frozen eggs, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh fruits, and evaporated and condensed milk.

Total red meats in freezers declined 8 percent from June 1984 but were 26 percent more than the July 1983 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 14 percent during the month but were 38 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 26 percent from last month but were 77 percent above the 1983 holdings.

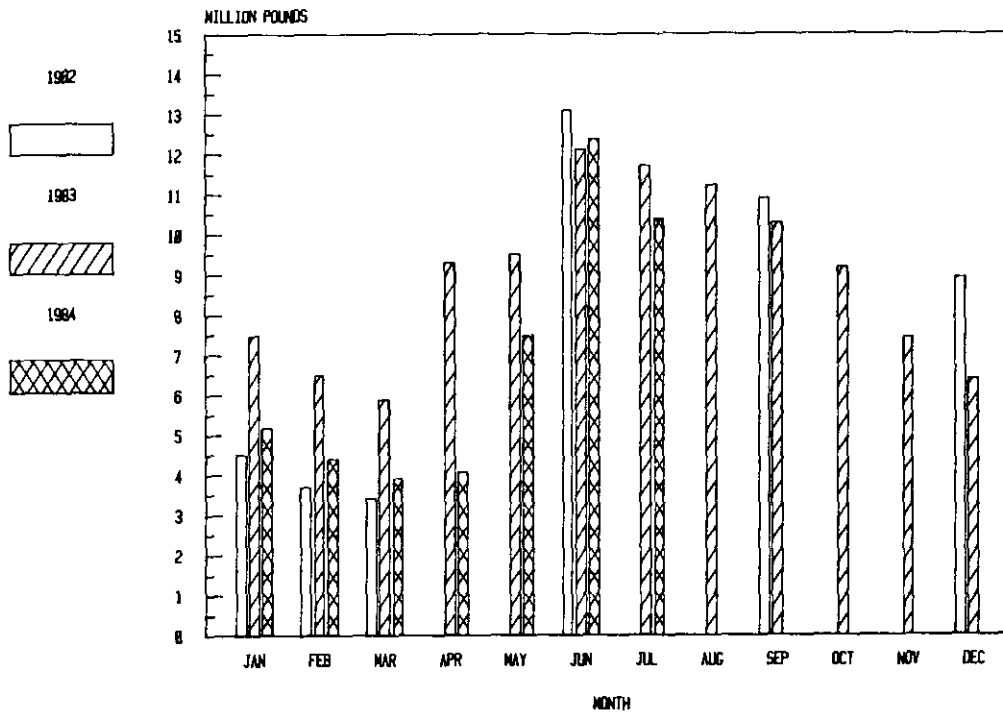

FROZEN ASPARAGUS COLD STORAGE STOCKS, 48 STATES 1982-1984

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 16 percent from June 1984 but were 15 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 9 percent during the month but were 11 percent below 1983. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 19 percent from last month but down 17 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 62 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 65 percent was 1 point above last month but 4 points below last year.
